Bullpen

Joe Nathan is the closer for Rye this year, for better or for worse. He can regularly come in in the middle of the 8th inning to get a 1 2/3 inning save.

Mattheus is the set-up man. 7th into the 8th. Betancourt is the 6th/7th guy. Javier Lopez and Joe Thatcher are the lefty specialists and short relief guys. Michael Bowden is there for longer relief. All that being stated, all of the bullpen guys can be used whenever it makes sense.

Don't worry about innings. I'll worry about that. Use the bullpen to try to win games. Use the bumps by bringing guys in mid-inning. These bullpen grades aren't high, and they need all the help they can get.

Offense

Hit and Run – The team has relatively high steal ratings, but not that many steal attempts. I'd like to focus more on the hit and run than straight steals. Keppinger is an h&r 3. Use that. Six guys are h&r 2. Use the hit and run with the guys with steal ratings greater than 26 on first, and any of the 2 or 3 h&r guys up.

Stealing – The above being said, if a run is needed to tie or win, consider stealing with the guys who have net steal ratings above 30.

Base Advances – Use the Adams Tables.

Bench – What bench you say? Well, it is what it is. Anyone on the bench can be used. Don't worry about usage. If a lefty comes in, use the guys who can hit lefties. Berkman can pinch hit against righties. Oddly enough, the team's pinch runner, if a tie or go ahead run is needed, is F15 Jeff Samardzija on days he doesn't pitch. 40 year old LaTroy Hawkins, with 13 speed is the next best, although he starts out in the minors.

Defensive Replacements – There are not many options. Miguel Olivo should catch late in close games. Kemp should be in the game late if he didn't start unless it's a blowout, and Brandon Inge can come in to play 3rd late in close games but only if Aramis Ramirez isn't due up the next inning. Use your judgment on that.

This team needs to win its division to make the playoffs, and that may be a close proposition. Pull out all managerial stops to win.
