## Offensive Strategies

**Strategy #1: Pray for rain.** This offense will struggle to score runs, so we'll be looking to manufacture them where we can.

**Hit and Run:** Hit and run designations are listed in the lineups above. Since there isn't much power on this team, employ whenever legal.

**Steal:**

- **Kipnis and Andrus** can attempt steals of 2nd, 4th inning or later if the score is +/- 2 runs.
- **Bruce** can attempt steals of 2<sup>nd</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> inning or later if the score is +/- 1 run.
- **Kipnis** can attempt a steal of 3<sup>rd</sup> as the go-ahead run, 8<sup>th</sup> or later.
- Don't attempt steals of home.

**Pinch Hitting:**

- The bench is very weak, so go with the lineups provided unless an injury or ejection occurs. If that happens, use your best judgment on the replacement.

**Pinch Running:**

- On any given day, there should be speed on the bench, so pinch run for a slow runner representing the winning/tying run 8<sup>th</sup> inning or later. **Leake** (speed 13) and **Arroyo** (speed 11) are also available.

**Runner Advancement:**

Board Game: Use Adams Tables

**Computer Game:**

Go when the runner is "well around". Otherwise try to score when:

- 0 out if (OF arm - Runner Speed) is less than 15
- 1 out if (OF Arm - Runner Speed) is less than 24
- 2 out if (OF Arm - Runner Speed) is less than 30

**Sacrifice:** If the score is within 2 runs and there's a runner on 2<sup>nd</sup> with no outs, sacrifice unless **Kiermaier, Coghlan, or S. Rodriguez** are at bat.

## Defensive Strategies

**Holding Runners on 1st:** Always hold unless one team (probably yours) leads by 5 runs or more.

**Play infield in:** Three cases-

- Runner on 3rd only: 0 or 1 out, 6th or later, Columbus +1 to -4
- Runners on 1st and 3rd: 8th or later, 0 out, Columbus +0 to -4
- Runners on 2nd and 3rd or bases loaded: only if winning run is on third, 9th inning or later, 0 or 1 out. (1out, bases full, play infield deep if batter has 2+ 24s on his card.)

**Intentional walk:** Your call - use it if it makes sense

**Outfield Throws:** Always throw for go-ahead run, 8th or later.

- Board Game- Throw for lead runner with less than 33/36 chances, otherwise cut the throw to hold training runners.
- Computer game- always throw for slow lead runner (speed 6 or less), throw for other runners unless "well around" otherwise cut the throw off to hold training runners.

**Defensive Replacements:**

Replace **S. Rodriguez** with at 1B with a 1B4 if we lead after batting in the 8th

### Starting Pitching Strategy:

Here are the general guidelines:

Never remove a pitcher throwing a shutout and never let a starter pitch more than 11.7 innings.

Tier I starters (**Tanaka and Fister**): Remove when fatigued or if a baserunner gets in scoring position, 7<sup>th</sup> or later, score +/- 2 runs. If you hit them for a five-point downgrade, let them continue.

Tier II starters (**Porcello and Leake**): These guys are on a shorter leash. Remove them if downgraded/fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 6<sup>th</sup> inning or later, score +/- 3 runs.

Tier III starters (**Arroyo, Salazar, and McCarthy**): Remove them if downgraded/fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 5<sup>th</sup> inning or later, score +/- 3 runs.

### Bullpen Strategy:

Closer: The few save opportunities we have this year will be in **David Robinson's** hands. He'll start the 9<sup>th</sup> in any game we lead by three or less.

Set-Up/ Middle Relief: Some combination of **Guerra (RH 12)**, **Badenhop (RH 11)**, **Choate (L10)**, **Furbush (L9)** will be up every month. They'll generally come in when the starter leaves and the game is within three runs. Mix and match them to your disadvantage.

Long Relief: One of **Gutierrez (R 8)** and **Fien (R 7)** will be available to rescue a Tier II or III starter that's been downgraded, or when the starter leaves and we're down by 4 or more.

Mop-up: Our grade 1 reliever (**Slowey**) will fill this role. Use him if you pound out a starter, or in blowout games where you're up by 7 or more runs after the 6<sup>th</sup>.
