## Offense:

Usage: C is very limited in games and there will be limited available moves because of restrictions

## Positions-

$\mathbf{1 B} / \mathbf{2 B} / \mathbf{3 B} / \mathbf{S S} / \mathbf{D H}-$ The infield is covered by Adrian Gonzalez, Anthony Rendon, Alexei Ramirez, Todd Frazier and the return of David Ortiz. These five will starts and finish most games.
C- Russell Martin and Chris Stewart are primary starters. Stewart starts against LH and will need to be PH for vs RHs. Gosewich can replace Stewart after PH or late in close game to prevent a steal
LF- Alex Gordon owns left most days.
CF- Ryan Braun will be CF for 135 games with De Aza or Bourjos picking up the rest
RF- JD Martinez vs LH and most RH. David Murphy will be start against selected RH. Generally JD will not be PH for with Bourjos, or any OF2 coming in for defense after JD bats in the $7^{\text {th }}$.
Bench- Forsythe will see some spare games around the infield and be available for injury replacement. Bourjos is a defensive bat and can run. De Aza is available as a PR late in the game to steal a base and has a big + against RHPs. Adrian Gonzalez, Anthony Rendon, Alexi Ramirez, Todd Frazier, David Ortiz, Alex Gordon and Ryan Braun should not come off the bench!!!

## Pinch Hitting:

1. De Aza or Murphy starting in RF can be PH with JD Martinez vs LHP, $6^{\text {th }}$ inning on if Melrose trails by $<4$.
2. PH for Stewart vs RH bat, after 2 PAs or $7^{\text {th }}$ inning, replace with Goeswich
3. Gosewich can be PH for $7^{\text {th }}$ on score -2 to 0 , replace with Stewart

## Pinch Running:

1. De Aza can PR for a slow runner, Ortiz, when tying or winning run $7^{\text {th }}$ or later.

Stealing: Stealing takes priority over Hit \& Run. Steals will be a bigger part of the offense this year. There are 4 starters with 20+ attempts and 3 with $10+$.

1. Look to steal $4^{\text {th }}$ inning on score +2 to -3
2. $\mathrm{SSN}>=25$
3. De Aza, Frazier, Ramirez, Rendon. Max 2 / series
4. Bourjos, Braun, Gordon. Max 1 / series.
5. $7^{\text {th }}$ inning or later. Score 0 to -1 . Murphy or Martin can attempt a steal, \#2 applies

Hit and Run: I like the hit and run.

1. Eligible batters will a fast runner on 1 st.
2. If pitcher is a W do not Hit and Run
3. 2 outs Hit and Run any eligible batter
4. Against grades $>12$ I tend to H\&R more often

## Sacrifice:

1. With $<1$ outs sacrifice with any weak batter $8^{\text {th }}$ or $9^{\text {th }}$ inn to move the tying or winning run over
2. Never Sac if H\&R in order
3. Never Squeeze! Never!

## Runner Advancement:

Boards: Use Adams table
Computer: $\quad G o$ when runner is well around bag
2 out F runner on second send them home
2 out $F$ runner on third send them home
F runner on third $<2$ out on Fly Ball arm $<=30$ send runner
Runner on $2^{\text {nd }}$, ball hit to CF or RF arm $<=31$ send runner

Bourjos/De Aza for any OF1 $7^{\text {th }}$ or later Melrose in the lead.
Replacement/Injuries: Use first available
3B-Forsythe/Rendon
1B-Forsythe/Frazier
SS-Forsythe
Outfield-De Aza/Bourjos

## Infield:

1. $<2$ out tying or winning run on third $7^{\text {th }}$ inn or later infield should play in. Infield plays back all other tir
2. Always hold runner on $1^{\text {st }}$ adjusted $\mathrm{SSN}>14$. Don't hold N 's
3. Pitch from stretch if runner on third is eligible to steal home $\operatorname{SSN}>157^{\text {th }}$ or later

## Pitching:

Melrose will have 76 starts of Grade 13 and the rest 8 or better. We are trying to win the division this year so protecting the lead is more important than getting innings out of the starters.


1. Never remove a starter if pitching a shutout
2. No starter pitches more than 11.2 innings. Even if pitching a shutout
3. Remove a starter as soon as fatigued/reduced, unless before the $4^{\text {th }}$ and game -5
4. The Starters
4.1. Lester/Ross are grade 13 Try to get them 7 innings See 4.4 below
4.2. Paxton has low fatigued. Try for 7 but remove as soon as fatigued unless score
4.3. Kazmir/Peralta/Voglesong 10/9/8 with neutral peripherals try for 6 full innings
4.4. Remove the starter if tying/winning run on $6^{\text {th }}$ or later.

## Relievers:

The bullpen is deep with 190 innings RH relief $18+$ and 27.3 innings of LH 20 in Edgin. There is another 162 inning of 17/16/13. There is a drop off in the pen from their. If the starter leaves early most early innings will be pitched by Pressley or Wright although don't hesitate to leverage one of the better relievers to get that key out and keep the game close.

1. Edgin has grade 20* but only 27.3 innings. He should be used a spot lefty in a jam to force the LH batter out of the game preferable against best apposing LH shift. Only use for 1 or 2 outs at a time.
2. AJ Ramos (21*), Todd Wilhemsen (21*), Pedro Strop (18*) - Primary Setup $7^{\text {th }}, 8^{\text {th }}$, and $9^{\text {th }}$ inning guys. All wild. Use Strop/Wilhemsen over Ramos in base loaded situation. Any can save a game but lean on Ramos because of +53 HR rating
3. Broxton (17*), Jespen (16*) - Primary $6^{\text {th }}$ and $7^{\text {th }}$ inning relief.
4. Freeman (13*) - Short inning spot LH Reliever. Use for 1 or 2 outs at a time. Can come in $6^{\text {th }}$ inning or later.
5. Pressley (9*), Wright (5*) - Mop up and long relief. Pressley should be saved for close games.

## Closing notes on Pitcher usage

The above are guidelines. Use your best judgment when managing the pen. The Avengers are trying to win games this year. Don't be afraid to remove the starter earlier or leverage the bullpen to get the road team the win.
