The mission of this team is to fininsh .500. That requires a twenty-two game improvement over 2015, an improbable goal but, with the influx of talent from the draft and trades, not impossible. The Indians will play the board game at home.

OFFENSIVE STRATEGY

HIT AND RUN

Starting in the 6th inning, score tied or Indians -1 to -2. No H&R with two outs or with runners on first and third. We will reserve that strategy for home games.

Baserunners: Burns, Inciarte, Duffy, Maybin, Hernandez, or Owings on first.

Batters: Burns, Inciarte, Duffy, or Cozart

STEALING

Starting in the 6th inning, score tied or Indians -1 to -2. **Burns** and **Inciarte** can steal 2B with +25 chances and a non-H&R batter at the plate.

Starting in the 8th, same situation, add Maybin, Hernanadez, and Owings to the list.

Everyone is limited to one straight steal chance per series. Continue to H&R, even if the baserunner has used his straight steal attempt.

PINCH HITTING

PH in the 8th or later with the winning or tying run in scoring position.

vs. a RHP use **Bour** for Cozart, Saltalamacchia, or Upton

vs. a LHP use Upton or Hernandez for Inciarte, Duffy, or Perez

PINCH RUNNING

In the 8th inning or later, PR for any slow runner in scoring position, if that runner represents the tying or winning run. Use **Chris Archer (F-15)** if Archer is not available, any (F) player on the bench is the second option.

SACRIFICE

Starting in the 7th, only with runner(s) on first, second, or first and second, no outs, tied or down one run. Do not sacrifice with **Cruz, Freeman, Longoria, Santana**, or **Suarez. RUNNER ADVANCEMENT**

BOARD GAME: Use the Adam's Tables

RUNNER ADVANCEMENT

COMPUTER GAME:

"Well around the bag" ---- send the runner home, and a runner to 3rd if hit is to CF or RF.

If the fielder plays a hit "on the long bounce", Send the runner only if he's fast. Don't send him to 3rd. On doubles to RF line, send the fast runner home but hold the slow runner. An average speed runner can score if the OF arm is <30.

On well-hit drives to right-center, when bases empty, where the runner "hits 2nd under a full head of steam" --- try for third if he hit any triples (in the real-life MLB season).

On singles to LF, an average or fast runner can score – but no one has a good shot at 3rd. On singles to CF and RF, fast runners have a good shot at 3rd, all runners should try to score.

When the fielder "retreats to get it", send the runner home.

DEFENSIVE STRATEGY

OUTFIELD THROWS

Throw for the lead runner unless the chances are 34+. Always throw for the tying/go-ahead in the 7th or later. COMPUTER GAME: Follow the same principles for throwing at your runners as outlined for my runners. HOLD RUNNER ON FIRST

When 1B(4or5) is playing first always hold. Otherwise:

a) Hold all fast runners.

b) Hold all average runners unless I have a lead of 2 or more and there is a PR hitter.

c) Hold slow runners only with a RH hitter or less than 2 out unless I lead by 2 or more.

d) Do not hold with 2 out and runners on 1st and 3rd unless runner on 1st is the lead or tying run.

PLAYING INFIELD IN

PLAY 'IN' starting in the 8th inning, 0 or 1 out, tying or go-ahead run on 3rd.

INTENTIONAL WALK

I only use this on those occasions when a monster hitter comes up with the game on the line. So its your call. **PITCH FROM THE STRETCH**

In the 6th or later, score tied or Indians up 1, with a threat on 3B.

DEFENSIVE REPLACEMENT: Owings for Suarez 8th inning with Indians +1.

INJURY SUBS:

- 1B Duffy or whichever catcher is not in the game.
- INF Duffy, Hernandez, Suarez, or Owings
- C Whichever catcher is not in the game. If something weird happens and the second catcher is already in the game at first, Santana will be the emergency catcher and the Indians will have to forego the DH.
- OF Upton first choice, Any OF on the bench, second choice.
- DH Best hitter on the bench.



PITCHING STRATEGY MANAGING THE STARTERS

Archer, Syndergaard, & S. Miller: The staff aces. Will pitch until fatigued after the 5th inning or into the 8th inning. Let them stay in if pitching a shutout. No problem letting them complete games, if the Indians are plus 4 or more.

Iglesias, Eickoff, & Conley: The middle men on the staff. Will pitch until fatigued after the 5th inning or into the 7th inning. If throwing a SHO, let them will stay in until they surrender their first earned run. Medlen: Will pitch until fatigued after the 4th inning or into the 6th inning. If throwing a SHO, he will stay in the game until they surrender their first earned run. Feldman: Back of the rotation guy. Pitch until fatigued after the 4th inning. If not fatigued, remove after the 5th inning, unless throwing a SHO.

USING THE BULL PEN

After the September trading period, the bull pen is much better armed for the stretch run. The Indians' pen is divided into groups. Here's what you need to know about each Reliever group. **GROUP A:** The closer. **Carter Capps** will have this job for October. He will attempt the save every time the starter is not in a complete game situation. With his grade and peripherals, he should be able to slam the door each time out. However, if **Capps** blows the save or pitches three games in a row,



Dalier Hinojosa will be the second option. Limit 1 innining per game.

GROUP B: The set-up group. Ryan Madson, Dalier Hionjosa, & Xavier Cedeno. The lefty/righty set-up guys.

can come in the 8th inning to maintain a lead and get to a save situation. All three are active this month.

Madson Limited to 2 innings per game. Hinojosa Limited to 1 inning, per game. Cedeno is more of a LOOGY. Bring him in to face a tough hitter with a minus (-) hitting split vs.lhp when a hit can win the game, 7th inning or later.

Cedeno is limited to two innings per series.

GROUP C: The Middleman. Chad Qualls. Pitch the 6th and 7th innings

when starter is fatigued and for the back end starters when they come out after five innings. Unless they are throwing a SHO. Limit two innings per game.

GROUP D: Long Reliever and extra innings guyer. Ryan Mattheus, will be active for October.

Can pitch any time if Indians are minus 5 or extra innings. No Limit.
