Offensive Strategies

Strategy #1: Hit and Run.

Hit and run designations are listed in the lineups above. Since there isn't much power on this team, employ whenever legal.

Strategy #2: Steal. If Adams Tables give the green light:

- **Kiermaier and Andrus** can attempt steals of 2nd, third inning or later if the score is +/- 2 runs.
- **Kipnis, Bruce, and Coghlan** can attempt steals of 2nd, seventh inning or later if the score is +/- 1 run.
- **Kiermaier, Andrus, and Kipnis** can attempt a steal of 3rd as the go-ahead run, 8th inning or later.
- Don't attempt steals of home.

Strategy #3: Sacrifice.

Sacrifice with the 1st, 2nd, 8th and 9th place hitters if:

- The score is tied or we're behind by one run.
- And there's a runner on 2nd with no outs
- And it's the 7th inning or later

Pinch Hitting: Look to PH 7th inning or later.

- **Garcia** (vs LHRP) and **Solarte** (vs RHRP) can pinch hit for each other

- **Raburn** can pinch hit for **Coghlan** vs LHRP
- Don't PH for **Kipnis, Castro, or Raburn**. They'll have to tough it out if their negative shifts come into play.
- However, if you have someone lurking in the bullpen to negate the pinch-hitter, don't make the move.

Pinch Running:

- On any given day, there should be speed on the bench, so pinch run for a slow runner representing the winning/tying run 8th inning or later. **Leake** (speed 13) may also be available.

Runner Advancement:

- Board Game: Use Adams Tables
- Computer Game: Go when the runner is "well around". Otherwise try to score when 0 out if (OF arm - Runner Speed) is less than 15
1 out if (OF Arm - Runner Speed) is less than 24
2 out if (OF Arm - Runner Speed) is less than 30

Defensive Strategies

Holding Runners on 1st: Always hold unless one team leads by 5 runs or more.

Play infield in: Three cases-

- Runner on 3rd only: 0 or 1 out, 6th or later, Columbus +1 to -4
- Runners on 1st and 3rd: 8th or later, 0 out, Columbus +0 to -4
- Runners on 2nd and 3rd or bases loaded: only if winning run is on third, 9th inning or later, 0 or 1 out. (1 out, bases full, play infield deep if batter has 2+ 24s on his card.)

Intentional walk: Your call - use it if it makes sense

Outfield Throws: Always throw for go-ahead run, 8th or later.

- Board Game- Throw for lead runner with less than 33/36 chances, otherwise cut the throw to hold training runners.
- Computer game- always throw for slow lead runner (speed 6 or less), throw for other runners unless "well around" otherwise cut the throw off to hold training runners.

Defensive Replacements:

Replace an OF1 with an OF2 if we lead after batting in the 8th

Starting Pitching Strategy:

Here are the general guidelines:

Never remove a starting pitcher who hasn't allowed an earned run and never let a starter pitch more than 11.7 innings.

Tier I starters (Tanaka and Salazar): Remove when fatigued or if a baserunner gets in scoring position, 7th or later, score +/- 2 runs.

Tier II starters (Leake and Nola): These guys are on a shorter leash. Remove them if downgraded/fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 6th inning or later, score +/- 3 runs.

Tier III starters (Anderson, Frias, Fister and Porcello): Remove them if downgraded/fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 5th inning or later, score +/- 3 runs.

Bullpen Strategy:

Closer: It'll be either **Furbush** or **Socolovich** depending on who's active that month. Innings are limited so only pitch them in 9th inning save situations. If they blow the save, take them out.

Set-Up/ Middle Relief: Some combination of **Lowe, Robertson, Hudson and Hernandez** will be up every month. They'll generally come in when the starter leaves and the game is within three runs. Use them as needed to take advantage of the +5 first batter upgrade.

Long Relief: **Fien and/or Badenhop** will be available to rescue a Tier II or III starter that's been downgraded, or when the starter leaves and we're down by 4 or more.

Mop-up: **Williams Perez or Matt Boyd** will fill this role. They **do not** get the +5 upgrade. Use them if you pound out a starter, or in blowout games where someone is up by 6 or more runs after the 6th.
