STRATEGY STATEMENTS

WHAT A TURNAROUND. Left for dead on the side of the road by preseason prognosticators, the Grand Cayman Havens found some inner strength — enough to play well enough to compete for a Wild Card berth. Several midseason trades added starting pitching depth and Melky Cabrera. Regarding substitutions: If it's tied or we lead, use the top end of the bullpen, starting in the 6th inning. If we're behind, either stay with the starter until fatigued or use the lower end of the bullpen. No DH? If you want to play at Grand Cayman with no DH, so will the Havens! We prefer it. Let us know ahead of time, so we can alter our instructions. Thanks.

Boards vs. LHPs

OFFENSIVE STRATEGY

HIT AND RUN

In general, H&R early and STEAL late in a close game.

BATTERS:

- Aoki, Cabrera, Seager, and Walker H&R whenever legal.
- Conforto, Crawford, Polanco, and Semien H&R only when the base runner on 1B has 27+ adjusted chances.

BASE RUNNERS:

• Aoki, Crawford, Jankowski, Polanco, Seager, Semien, and Walker. Add Encarnacion when 8s are stolen.

Board Game: With 1B-and-3B, H&R only with 0 or 2 out. **Computer Game:** Never H&R with 2 outs.

STEALING

- Aoki and Polanco can steal 2B with 25+ chances in the 4th or later, score within 1 run.
- Add Crawford, Encarnacion, Holliday, Jankowski, Semien, and Walker in the 7th or later, with 24+ chances.
- Don't steal 3B or home.
- Aoki can steal twice in a series, and Polanco as often as needed, as long as the game's within 1 run. Limit all other runners to 1 attempt per series.
- Continue to H&R even if the base runner has used his attempt.

PINCH-HITTING

See the Player-by-Player Usage Chart on the next page. MAINTAIN THE BEST DEFENSE IF WE LEAD.

PINCH-RUNNING

See the Usage Chart. PR with Jankowski or Semien. Cingrani has 13 speed to PR for runners in scoring position.

SACRIFICE

When appropriate, with no outs; a runner on 2B or 1B-and-2B; tied or down 1 run; 6th inning or later. Do not squeeze.

RUNNER ADVANCEMENT

Board Game: Use the Adams Tables. Computer Game: Play our team like your own team.

DEFENSIVE STRATEGY

OUTFIELD THROWS

Throw for the lead runner unless the chances are 34+. Always throw for the tying/go-ahead runner in the 6th or later. Computer Game: Follow this principle.

HOLD RUNNER ON FIRST

NEVER HOLD vs. a PR hitter. Otherwise, hold if the score is within 4 runs, UNLESS the runner is no threat to steal.

PLAY INFIELD IN

PLAY IN from the 7th inning, 0–1 out, tying/go-ahead run on 3B.

INTENTIONAL WALK

Barry's seen it work. Use it sparingly, when it makes sense.

PITCH FROM THE STRETCH

In the 6th or later, score tied or we're up 1, with a threat on 3B.

PITCHING STRATEGY

MANAGING THE STARTERS

We try to win the games we lead, although try to avoid the pen before the 6th inning. When a starter fatigues*, check the score: if it's tied or we're ahead, use the good relievers aggressively.

With **127.7 relief innings** of Grade 7* and higher left this year, our starters have to carry their share of the load. For some of the 12 starting pitchers we'll use this year, it will be a heavy load.

We have three rules this year:

- 1. DO NOT REMOVE A STARTER THROWING A SHUTOUT.
- 2. NO STARTER SHOULD PASS 11.7 INNINGS IN ANY GAME.
- 3. EVERY STARTER* PITCHES INTO THE 6TH INNING.

*Rea (**R**) and Smyly (**S**) have decent grades, but short fatigues. They *try* to make it into the 6th inning. Smyly can fatigue once. If he fatigues again or if **Rea** fatigues at all, check the score. If it's tied or we lead, go to the bullpen (see the Quick Reference Guide on the next page). If we trail, even by 1 run, they stay in until the 6th. Then reassess.

Bolsinger (\mathbf{M}), **Teheran** (\mathbf{T}), and **Wilson** (\mathbf{W}) pitch 6 innings or until fatigued. In the 7th, if the score is within 3 runs, go to the pen at the first base runner. Otherwise, they can stay in.

Chavez (C) and **Colon** (B) have to pitch into the 6th inning. If it's tied or we lead, go to the pen at the next base runner. If we trail, let them get through the inning. In the 7th, reassess the situation before going to the pen.

Cingrani (A) and **Worley** (V) go 4 innings. If we gain an advantage, go to the lower end of the bullpen and work your up the chain to protect the lead. If we're behind by 2+ runs, let them get their work in. Do your best to manage the bullpen.

USING THE BULLPEN

We have a good top end of the bullpen and some overperforming middle relievers. This year's pen has **236.3 relief innings** (**5.7 innings per game**) left, although only **127.7 innings** are Grade 7* or higher (**3.0 innings per game**). The relievers are split into five groups. Refer to the QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE, but here's what you need to know:

Group 1: Wade Davis reprises his role as the Closer. He has **20.0 innings** left to slam the door. He may come into a tie game or with a 1–3-run lead in the 8th to squash a rally for a six-out save. Limit: **1.7 innings per game**.

Group 2: With **36.7 innings** left between them, the set-up crew comes in when it's tied or we have a lead in the 7–9th innings. THEY NEVER PITCH IF WE TRAIL. **Bastardo** is the LHP. **Barraclough-Grimm** (as one reliever) gives us **22.0 innings**; only one RHP is active at a time. <u>Limit: 1.3 innings per game</u>.

Group 3: This part of the pen is a bit uneven. **Worley** is solid, but **Diaz** and **Neris** have HR issues. All are right-handed. All three together have **54.7 innings** left (about **18.0** innings each) to do the best they can to keep us in the game or protect an early lead. <u>Limit: 1.3 innings per game.</u>

Group 4: Hunter and **Chavez** (both in November) provide relief if we're behind or it's too early for anyone else. These two relievers have **16.3 innings** to keep the game close in the 4–8th innings. <u>Limit: 2.0 innings per game</u>.

Group 5: At the bottom of the bullpen are **Cingrani**, **Norris**, and **Otero**. They have **100.7 innings**, and they're all ugly. Their job is to save the better relievers' innings in blowouts. They never pitch when it's tied or we lead. They can go long, EVEN PAST FATIGUE. Limit: **2.7+ innings per game**.

First, review MANAGING THE STARTERS and USING THE BULLPEN on the previous page. Use this **QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE** to determine which **RELIEVER GROUP** to bring in (and when). Some groups may have only one active pitcher. If we need a reliever for innings 1–4, go to Group 5 to soak up innings. If the mop's forced to leave, spread the work around; don't overuse any one reliever.
