## offensiye strategies

Hit and Run (check first)
The hit \& run returns as a viable offensive strategy. There could be as many as 6 hitters in the lineup capable of being on the front end of a hit \& run. I use it mainly to avoid a DP, and to a less degree to give a hitter with a large penalty shift penalty a slightly better chance. If you're the type that likes this strategy, I say have at it, but just make sure the runner has an SSN of 26 or higher after adjustments and steal attempts to spare. Most of our hit \& run eligible hitters are not the best at making contact and I'm OK with steal attempts being used here.

## Stealing

Look to steal $2^{\text {nd }}$ when $H$ \& R is not an option and we can put a runner on $2^{\text {nd }}$ with less than 2 outs $7^{\text {th }}$ or later, and the baserunner is either Galvis, Lindor, Marisnick or Reddick. Check active roster to make sure there are steal attempts remaining.

## Sacrifice

With $8^{\text {th }}$ or $9^{\text {th }}$ place hitter if score is $+/-2$ runs, 0 outs, runner on $1^{\text {st }}$ or $1^{\text {st }} \& 2^{\text {nd }}$ only.

## Pinch-Hitting

When behind by 2 or less, after $6^{\text {th }}$.

- vs. RHP: Rogers, Castro, and Reddick (if not starting), Denorfia (when active)
- vs. LHP: Baez, Ozuna, Castellanos, d'Arnaud


## Pinch-Running

For any slow (<9 spd) runner, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later, tie or winning run on, less than 2 outs, possibility of a steal

## Outfield Throws

Always throw for lead runner if chances are $<32$, trailing runner if chances are $<20$, unless lead runner is tie or go ahead, $7^{\text {th }}$ or later.

## Hold Runner on First

Hold all runners regardless of speed.

## Play Infield In

Deep at all times except:

- $\quad 3^{\text {rd }}$ or $2^{\text {nd }} \& 3^{\text {rd }},<2$ outs, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later, tie or winning run on $3^{\text {rd }}$
- Bases full, 0 outs, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later, tie or winning run on $3{ }^{\text {rd }}$


## Defensive Replacements

If we lead by 3 or less after $7^{\text {th }}$.

- Baez or Colon for Castro in the infield
- Reddick, Marisnick, \& Ozuna in the outfield

## Managing the Starters

This is where it gets tough. Only two double digit starters with bad control, a generic 6 and 7, and the rest borderline innocuous. Those 3's \& 4's could play havoc with bullpen usage, so do the best you can to: 1) conserve relief innings when possible; i.e. go to league maximum runs allowed in lost causes while 2 ) spreading the workload around when a starter leaves early.

## Using the Bullpen

The bullpen is essentially staffed by situational \& setup types with no clear choice for closing. Quickly scanning the grades one notices a degree of sameness with nothing below a 10 or above a 16. Doesn't sound so bad except when you check the peripherals. We either issue base on balls or uncatchable deep flies but almost never by the same guy. That's why a reliever chart or specific roles does not fit this group.

We will have 7 relievers available each month including 2 or more lefties, and a starter turned reliever (Tomlin). I may suggest how certain relievers should be used, but ultimately it will be the road manager's decision and which guy fits the situation. This could change with waiver acquisitions, but for now this is how we will set things up.
