# **Offensive Strategies**

These are representative lineups. I will send out series specific lineups by the 4th.

#### Strategy 1: Hit and Run.

Hit and run designations are listed in the lineups above. Employ whenever legal.

**Strategy 2: Steal.** If the hit and run isn't an option, attempt to steal with the following runners if the adjusted SSN > 27.

- Kiermaier and Andrus can attempt steals of 2nd, third inning or later if the score is +/- 2 runs.
- Kipnis, Rua, and Votto can attempt steals of 2<sup>nd</sup>, seventh inning or later if the score is +/- 1 run.
- Kiermaier, Andrus, and Kipnis can attempt a steal of 3<sup>rd</sup> as the go-ahead run, 8<sup>th</sup> inning or later.
- · Don't attempt steals of home.

### Strategy 3: Sacrifice.

Sacrifice with the 8th and 9th place hitters if:

- The score is tied or we're behind by one run.
- And there's a runner on 2<sup>nd</sup> with no outs

• And it's the 7<sup>th</sup> inning or later

**Pinch Hitting/Running**: Not much of an option this year as the roster is game limited and the bench is very thin. Unless injured, the starters play the whole game.

In case of injury, use Coghlan if available. Otherwise, select the best option off the bench.

#### **Runner Advancement:**

- Board Game: Use Adams Tables
- Computer Game: Go when the runner is "well around". Otherwise try to score when
  out if (OF arm Runner Speed) is less than 15
  out if (OF Arm Runner Speed) is less than 24
  out if (OF Arm Runner Speed) is less than 30

#### **Defensive Strategies**

## Holding Runners on 1st:

- Always hold **fast** runners
- Hold **average** speed runners unless the Jets lead by 3 or more.
- Don't hold **slow** runners unless the batter is RH and the Jets lead by 3 or more.

#### Play infield in: Three cases-

- Runner on 3rd only: 0 or 1 out, 6th or later, Columbus +1 to -4
- Runners on 1st and 3rd: 8th or later, 0 out, Columbus +0 to -4
- Runners on 2nd and 3rd or bases loaded: only if winning run is on third, 9th inning or later, 0 or 1 out. (1 out, bases full, play infield deep if batter has 2+ 24s on his card.)

<u>Intentional walk</u>: If the go-ahead run is in scoring position, 8<sup>th</sup> inning or later with first base open:

• With one out, if on deck hitter has more than 2 24s

- With two outs, if batter is superior to the on deck
- Do not walk the bases loaded if the pitcher has a negative control rating.

<u>Pitch from stretch</u>: Always pitch from the stretch if there are runners on base.

<u>Outfield Throws</u>: Always throw for go-ahead run, 8th or later. Otherwise:

- Board Game-Throw for lead runner with less than 33/36 chances, otherwise cut the throw to hold training runners.
- Computer game- always throw for slow lead runner (speed 6 or less), throw for other runners unless "well around" otherwise cut the throw off to hold training runners.

**<u>Pitching Strategy:</u>** These are **general** guidelines. Managing the opposing pitching staff is the hardest part of the game, so use your best judgment and I'll be happy.

Never remove a starting pitcher who hasn't allowed an earned run and never let a starter pitch more than 11.7 innings.

Tier I starters (Fulmer, Tanaka, and Porcello): Remove when fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 7<sup>th</sup> or later, score +/- 2 runs. They can survive one 5-point downgrade.

Tier II starters (Manaea and Velasquez): These guys are on a shorter leash. Remove them if downgraded/fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 6th inning or later, score +/- 3 runs.

Tier III starters (Boyd and Nola): Remove them if downgraded/fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 5th inning or later, score +/- 3 runs.

Bullpen Strategy: This is a very mediocre (if you stretch the definition of mediocre) bullpen - the highest grade is a 16\* and many of the relievers have negative control ratings. Do what you can to maneuver the bullpen's limited resources to our best advantage.

"Closer": McGowan is the best we have so it'll be up to him to pitch the 9<sup>th</sup> in tie game/closing situations.

Set-Up: These duties will fall to Shaw and Robertson. They pitch the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> in games we're tied or leading.

Middle Relief: Some combination of Moylan, Guerra, Hernandez, and Kintzler will be up every month. They'll generally come in when the starter leaves and the game is within three runs. If a series of batters allergic to LHRP are coming up (and you don't plan on PHing for them) Rogers is also available. Use these pitchers as needed to take advantage of the +5 first batter upgrade.

Long Relief/Mop-up: If not already used, Rogers will be available to rescue a Tier II or III starter that's been downgraded, or when the starter leaves and we're down by 4 or more. Let him pitch two innings and then spread the pain around to the middle relief guys if necessary. Later in the season Leake may also be called on in this role. Leake is not eligible for the +5 upgrade.
