## Pitching Strategies

Starters: As usual, never remove a starter pitching a shutout and never let a starter pitch more than 11.7 innings. Star's have plenty of relief innings this year so go to relievers early and often. Here are the general guidelines:
Roark, Miranda and DeSclafani have good grades. They should stay in until they fatigue. Then if the score is within 4 runs, go to the bullpen. If we're up or down by 5 runs or more, they can stay in until they fatigue a second time. Then go to the pen.
Anderson, Gonzalez, and Urias have decent grades to keep us in the game, but not the best. Based on the game situation you should remove them: •When fatigued • If reduced, but the score is still within 4 runs • Any time from the 5th inning on - runner on base or in scoring position, score within 4 runs - when we need to stop a rally, maintain a lead, or keep the game close.
Bettis fills out the bottom of the rotation for 32 starts. Try to get him to the 5th inning, but after he's surrendered his first earned run, whenever that happens, consider bringing in the early reliever at the next base runner. If he makes it to the 5th inning or later, go to the pen immediately if he gives up a base runner with the score within 5 runs unless pitching a shutout.

Relievers: Something new for Detroit this year is that we have a deep bullpen with 442 innings of Grade 10* or higher. Refer to our new relief QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE for usage but here's generally what you need to know:

Group 1: Cishek and Ottavino become the closers. They have 91 innings to stop hits, walks, and homers. They only come in with a 1-3-run lead in the 8th or 9th for the save. Limit: 1.7 innings per game.
Group 2: With 124 innings between them, Dull and Law come in when it's tied or we have a lead in the 7th-9th or down by 1 in 7th-8th innings. They can close, too, if needed. Limit: 2.0 innings per game.
Group 3: The set-up crew of Torres, Salas \& Altavilla have 168 innings to pitch in close games from the 5th inning. Limit: 2.7 innings per game.
Group 4: Relievers Ramirez \& Ohlendorf pitch if we're behind or as mops. They have 144 innings to keep us in the game in the 3rd-8th innings. There are lots of innings; be aggressive with these pitchers. Limit: 2.7 innings per game.
Group 5: Relievers Greene will also pitch if we're behind or as a mop. He adds an additional 60 innings to keep it close in the 3rd-8th innings. Limit: 2.7 innings per game.

Stretch: Have all pitchers pitch from the stretch with tying or winning run on 3 b in $8^{\text {th }}$ or $9^{\text {th }}$ inning.

## Defensive Strategies:

Holding runners on 1st: Never hold if score is $+4 /-4$. Otherwise, always hold with two out or with PL at bat. If less than two out and SA or PR at bat, hold if base SSN is greater than 18 and your runner has steal attempts remaining. Throw at all base stealing attempts.

Outfield Throws: Always throw for go-ahead run. Board Game -Throw for lead runner with less than $34 / 36$ chances, otherwise throw to hold trailing runners. Computer game- always throw for slow lead runner, throw for average and fast lead runners unless "well around", otherwise throw to hold trailing runners.

Play infield in when a runner reaches 3 b , with less than 2 outs, in the 7 th inning or later if the Stars are behind by two or less, tied, or up one $(+1$ to -2$)$.
Defensive replacements: If DET leads after batting in eighth by 3 runs or less, if available put:

1) Rasmus or Taylor in LF, Myers to 1B. 1b removed. 2) Espinosa to 3b for Healy, unless Healy to bat in ninth, then remove him in the ninth if DET still up by 3 runs or less.. 3) Pennington to $2 b$ for Travis unless Travis to bat in ninth, then remove him in the ninth if DET still up by 3 runs or less.

Offensive Strategies (in order of preference)
Steal: Bourn, Ketel, Myers and Taylor steal second in the $8^{\text {th }}$ and 9 th inning with less than 2 outs if they represent the tying or lead run. However Myers should steal second anytime he reaches 1 b from the $6^{\text {th }}$ inning on.

Hit and Run: $H \& R$ if $+1 /-3$ run differential with 0 or 1 out, with Bourn, Espinosa, Franklin, Marte, Myers or Taylor running with Bourn, Descalso, Healy, Marte, Taylor or Valencia hitting. Do not hit and run if your pitcher's control is worse than -26 on the board game or has a W on the computer.

Sacrifice: Pennington and Taylor, any inning, no outs, runners on first, or first and second.
Runner Advancement: Board Game- Use Adams Tables. Computer Game- always try for the extra base when "well around".
Pinch hitting: No pinch hitting required.
Pinch running: Marte, Taylor, Espinosa, Rasmus or Pennington can pinch run for $5 / 6$ speed runner in the 9 th if they are the tying or winning run.
