## OFFEMSIVE STRATEGIES

## Hit and Run

My preferred method of creating scoring opportunities. Given the relatively limited number of steal attempts, these opportunities may only present 2 or 3 times per game. I'd prefer to see the better contact hitters, Castrol, Ozuna, Lindor, and d'Arnaud at bat with the runner having an SSN of 25 or higher after adjustments

## Stealing

If the hit and run is not an option, and the runner on first is Lindor, Reddick, Baez, Galvis, Marisnick or Dahl, consider stealing if the SSN is 27 or greater after adjustments, and the score is $+/-2$ runs in any inning

## Sacrifice

With any hitter except Joyce, Castellanos or Piscotty. $6^{\text {th }}$ inning later, score $0 /-2$.

## Pinch-Hitting

When behind by 2 or less, after $6^{\text {th }}$.

- vs. RHP: Bell, Castellanos, Galvis, Reddick, Almora
- vs. LHP: Almora, Piscotty, Baez, Ozuna, Bell.


## Pinch-Running

For any $<8$ speed runner, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later, tie or winning run on, less than 2 outs

## defensily strategies

## Outfield Throws

Always throw for lead runner if chances are $<32$, trailing runner if chances are $<20$, unless lead runner is tie or go ahead, $7^{\text {th }}$ or later.

## Hold Runner on First

Hold all runners regardless of speed.

## Play Infield In

Deep at all times except:

- $\quad 3^{\text {rd }}$ or $2^{\text {nd }} \& 3^{\text {rd }},<2$ outs, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later, tie or winning run on $3^{\text {rd }}$
- Bases full, 0 outs, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later, tie or winning run on 3 rd


## Defensive Replacements

If we lead by 3 or less after $7^{\text {th }}$.

- McCann catching, Baez on 3rd, Piscotty on 1 st
- Reddick, Marisnick (if active), plus any OF-2 in the outfield

## Managing the Starters

Slightly better than last year in- so- far- as there are 73 double digit starts, a passable 8 -lefty, then we hover near the innocuous mark for the remainder. Mr "f--ing Warmth" Mike Caldwell would be impressed at how 2 of the starters are fly ball extremists.

## Using the Bullpen

We will begin the season with a 6-man bullpen. However, we may have to add an arm down the road to keep the early and middle guys from burning through their usage too quickly. Monthly series instructions will list relievers usage remaining for the season
This staff features 2 closer types, although one could be considered more the set-up guy. It may come down to what type of hitters they are facing to determine who closes the game. Phelps from the right side and Flynn from the left, both are similar in that their control is a bit off, but they tend to limit the long ball. One can certainly set up the other as the situation dictates. From there are middle inning (Jeffeess, O'Rourke, Ramirez, and Tepera) and early entrant types (Alvarez, Nuno, and Crockett) with not a ton of usage and short fatigue.
