## The 2018 Barbarian Mood Statement

This is not your 2017 Barbarians. Not even close. The hitters have many of the same names, but they are either injured (Trout, Correa) or regressed (everyone else). The names look scary but their cards are just average. We will score some runs but not 900+ as we did last season. Also missing are some well identified bench players, replaced by guys who are young and will hopefully develop. There is some bench, but not much, and it isn't very useful. Most days the starters will finish unless you can find a creative way to eek an advantage from the limited bench and you are encouraged to do so. Have fun-we aren't going anywhere this season, it is a pietre dish for the 2020 and 2021 Barbarians who will do their best UCONN women's basketball imitation and go on a 108 game winning streak and win add back-to-back titles (so says Psychic Anna, so it must be true!)

As "average" as the offense is, it is still the strength of the team. That will be obvious as soon as you look at the rotation. There are 28 starts of the best Stephen Strasburg to date. There are 25 starts of the two headed "Sanchneda" (almost rhymes with "Sharknado") that would be a marginal \#5 starter on most teams. Then there is the rest: 109 starts of, to put it mildly, inflammable, incendiary, self-destructive "stuff". Low grades, wild, and prone to give up extra homers. The bullpen would be adequate for a good+ starting staff, but for these guysnot so much. I give some broad relief usage instructions to try and get through the season, but it boils down to this: try to win the winnable games, and cover the eyes of all small children for the rest.

At home we plan on having a lot of "fun giveaways" to try and keep the attendance figures reasonable; we suggest you do the same when the Barbarians come to your town. It should help. Rest your older starters. Enjoy padding your stats. Relish in getting revenge for the past few years. And in the words of Arnie, "We'll be back", and Vlad will remember.

--First choice for injury sub

Hays:
--Second choice for injury sub
--Second choice as PR
--Very rarely to PH for Nimmo

Mesoraco
--ONLY if there is no other legal option
(Injury sub at catcher is the only one I can think of)

## The Unbench (Guys who don't come out)

I can think of no reason Trout, Betts, Bradley, Correa, Machado, Fisher, Moncada, or Villar would ever leave the game voluntarilly. There just isn't anything better available on the bench.

Every starter MUST pitch 4 innings unless the rules require him to leave. Other than that:

## Strasburg:

The goal is to win almost all the games he starts. He will stay in until either: (1) he is reduced twice and the score is $+3 /-2$, or (2) he's reduced once, the score is $+3 /-1$, and runner gets is on base in the 7th or later, or (3) it is time for Kimbrell.

## Sanchez \& Pineda:

Some days they will get pounded, some days they will give us a chance. When they have a good day, we will use some of our better relievers. When they are getting pounded, let them suffer. It builds character, or so they say.
Relieve them if: (1) they are reduced and the game is $+3 /-2$ or (2) the score is $+3 /-2$, and runner gets is on in the 7 th or later or (3) it is time for Kimbrell.

## All others

Relieve them if the score is $+4 /-2$ and they put a runner on in the

## The Relievers

Holder, Oh, Montas, Krol: Any Inning. Generally their pitch:
(1) Whenever I trail by 4 or more and the starter is out of the game
(2) A starter leaves in the 4th inning or earlier regardless of score

The grades 9 through 14: Not before the 6th inn. Their roles:
(1) The game is in the 6th Inn+ and the score is $+3 /-2$
(2) Kimbrell has blown a save and we go into extra innings

NOTE: Krol can also be used here as a lefty killer for 1 or 2 outs
Kimbrell: ONLY in save situations:
Can start the 9th if we lead by 1 or 2
Can come in if a runner is on as early as one out in the 8th If he blows the save he can finish that half inning then comes out Limit Kimbrell to 4 IP per series.

Note: I will have 8 relievers up each month with 2 LHP.
Mix and match, play the shifts, and leverage the +5 s
Harris + Osuna is essentially one reliever with 119 innings
Bedrosian + Middleton is one reliever with 102 innings
Claudio is 82 innings of the only good LH I have
I trust your judgement to use these guys in the games that are winnable, but if it is--or later becomes--out of hand, same them to fight another day. This is not the offense that will erase big leads very often.

Mesoraco and Nimmo will be game limited and should not come off the bench unless there is no other option (injury, etc.)

## General comments:

This offence has 2 quite good hitters (Correa, Trout), a few servicable ones, and far too many bad ones. This is not a team that can wait for a lot of three-run homers, but it also doesn't have the good on-base and contact hitters to play small ball very effectively. There's speed but few good H\&R options since as all Barbarian offenses, we love our 13s.

SBA limits:
For now, limit Villar to 2 SBA attempts (straight steal or H\&R resulting in a SBA) per series
Machado, Trout, Betts, and Bradley limited to 1 SBA per series. That does not imply they have to use them!
Small Ball general thinking:
In general with Betts or Machado at bat I will opt for H\&R over steals. Others do not H\&R on the road.
Stealing, if appropriate, will take precidence over a SAC. Having said that, here is some guidance.
When to H\&R (priority over steal or SAC):
--Any inning, any \# of outs, runner on 1st base only
--Betts or Machado at bat, Villar, Machado, Trout, Betts, or Bradley on 1st
--Adjusted SSN 22 or better (or use Adams tables if you use them for your team)
When to steal (priority ove SAC):

- -Score must be $+2 /-2$, innings 4 through 7 or $+2 /-1$ in 8 th inning or later
--Adjusted SSN 28 or better (or use the Adams tables if you do that for your team)
When to SAC:


## Runner on 1st only, or 1st \& 2nd:

--Only with no outs (or with 1 out if it is the \#9 hitter at bat)
--Score must be $+3 /-3$, innings 4 through 7 or $+2 /-1$ in 8 th inning or later
--With any of the bottom three in the order, but NOT with Davis
--call it off with 2 strikes if the batter is Fisher

## Runner on 2nd only:

--Only with no outs

- -Score must be $+3 /-3$, innings 4 through 7 or $+2 /-1$ in 8 th inning or later
--With any of the bottom three in the order, but NOT with Davis
--call it off with 2 strikes if the batter is Fisher
Baserunning: tagging up, taking the extra base, etc.
We need to be more aggressive than normal, and fortunately we have a good amount of speed.
If you use the Adams, please use them for mine, except subtract 2 unless Correa or Trout is the next hitter
If you do not use the Adams tables, please be slightly more aggressive than you would be for your guys
--If you are uncertain, send them
Pinch hitting, pinch running:
These will be quite rare this season. The guys on the bench just don't have much to offer. See comments on the "Minors, Defense, \& Bench" page.
