## Offensive Strategies

Strategy 1: Hit and Run
Hit and run designations are listed in the lineups above. Employ when legal.

Strategy 2: Steal. If the hit and run isn't an option, and the score is $+2 /-2$, attempt to steal second with the following runners:

- Andrus and Kiermaier anytime with an adjusted SSN > 27.
- Kendrick, Santana, and Brantley $5^{\text {th }}$ inning or later with an adjusted SSN $>27$

Strategy 3: Sacrifice with the $8^{\text {th }}$ and $9^{\text {th }}$ place hitters if the score is tied or we're behind by one run AND there's a runner on $2^{\text {nd }}$ base with no out AND it's the $7^{\text {th }}$ inning or later

## Runner Advancement: <br> Board Game - use Adams Tables

Computer Game - Go when the runner is "well around", otherwise try to score when 0 out if (OF Arm - Runner Speed) is less than 15 1 out if (OF Arm - Runner Speed) is less than 24 2 out if (OF Arm - Runner Speed) is less than 30

Pinch Running: Look to PR for our catchers if they represent the tying or go-ahead run in the $8^{\text {th }}$ inning or later.

Pinch Hitting: On the computer, let the batters play through their shifts. On the boards, pinch-hit for Kiermaier and Barnhart if facing a LHRP $7^{\text {th }}$ inning or later and we're behind by 3 runs or less.

## Defensive Strategies

Holding Runners on $1^{\text {st. }}$ : Always hold if Votto is playing first. Otherwise hold fast and average runners with SBA remaining

## Play Infield in - Three cases

Runner on $3^{\text {rd }}$ only, 0 or 1 out, $6^{\text {th }}$ or later, Jets +1 to -4 Runners on $1^{\text {st }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}, 8^{\text {th }}$ or later, 0 out, Jets +0 to -4 Runners on $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ or bases loaded, only if winning run is on third, $9^{\text {th }}$ inning or later, 0 or 1 out. ( 1 out, bases full, play infield deep if batter has $2+24$ s on their card)

Intentional Walk: If the go-ahead run is in scoring position, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later with first base open:
With one out if on-deck hitter has $3+24 \mathrm{~s}$
With two outs if batter is superior to on-deck hitter
Don't walk the bases loaded if the pitcher who will face the on-deck hitter has a W or a negative control rating.

Pitch from stretch: Always when runners are on base

Outfield Throws: Always throw for the go-ahead run, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later. Otherwise-
Board Game - throw for lead runner with less than $33 / 36$ chances, otherwise cut the throw to hold trailing runners.

Computer Game- Always throw for slow lead runner, throw for other runners unless "well around" otherwise cut the throw to hold trailers.

Defensive Replacements: Barnhart for Castro, Sogard for Kendrick and OF3 for OF2 if Jets lead by less than 3 after we hit in the $8^{\text {th }}$.

Pitching Strategy These are general guidelines. You have the freedom to make whatever pitching decisions you deem appropriate within the flow of the game. We have 52 grade 10 and 11 starts; the remaining 110 starts are grade 7 s . That means the bullpen will almost always be better than the starter. There are plenty of bullpen innings so don't be shy about going to the pen if the game is competitive. As always, never remove a starter who hasn't allowed an earned run and never let a starter pitch more than 11.7 innings.

Nola and Fulmer: Remove if downgraded/fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, $6^{\text {th }}$ inning or later, score $+/-3$ runs.

The other starters: Remove if downgraded/fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, $5^{\text {th }}$ inning or later, score $+/-3$ runs.

## Bullpen:

- The closer is Robertson. He starts the $9^{\text {th }}$ in all save situations and can come in the $8^{\text {th }}$ to shut down a rally.
- Set up roles belong to a pair of grade 16 s , Brebbia and Moylan. The generally pitch the $7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ innings in games that we're leading or within a run.
- We have bunch of grade 11,12 , and 13 relievers that will fill the middle relief role. They will usually be the first pitchers in after the starter is removed before the 7 th. If you're threatening, I don't mind if you run them in and out of the game taking advantage of the +5 making them grades 16,17 and 18 for a batter.
- If Boyd is active use him in the long relief/mop-up role. He's not eligible for the +5 . If he's inactive, spread the pain around the pen.
- We have three lefty relievers on the roster, two of which will be active most months. Use them strategically against the leftychallenged part of your lineup.
