Road Managers with computer Game – please do <u>not</u> use any automatic managers, send game sheets. GC will play the board game at home. **Please wait for road instructions as my lineups will be customized for each series.**

- 3. Pinch Hitting Catchers can swap off for each other. Only if game on line Pirela can hit for Dyson. All others will tend to stay in game.
- 4. Pinch Runner (rare) for slow 8<sup>th</sup> on, when game on line. Dyson if available for the steal.
- 5. Defensive Substitutes Dyson to CF if not starting
- 6. Sacrifice; Any player not having a first column "1" on 66 and often those with bad shifts even with a "1" to keep them in game will sac on no out, man on second or 1st and 2nd, pitcher "B" or better, score close, late (**but not with Zimmerman or Schimpf or Stanton**). Ditto for man on first, steal not recommended (especially if adjusted pitching grade over 18). Squeeze bunt ONLY with runners on 3rd, or 2nd and 3rd, 8th or later, score within 1, fast runner. Batter with less than 5-13's
- 7. Stealing 2nd: Pham or Dyson after 5th inning and could try to steal 3rd or home when it makes sense. Gyorko or Kinsler can try to steal  $2^{nd}$  in the  $8^{th}$  inning or later.
- 8. Hit and Run –Gentry, Machado, Lucroy, Escobar, Dyson will H&R with man on first, or men on first and third with 0 or 2 outs. **<u>But</u>** only if runner on first listed under steals or is Gentry or Escobar.
- **11.** Intentional Walk: If score not close late, big hitter can walk in front of whimp on 2 out, but don't put tying/winning run on base.
- **12.** Pitch from Stretch: On 2 out, for adjusted SSN to steal home of 12 or more; on less than 2 out, with adjusted SSN of 15 or more (or 12 if pitcher grade 20 or more).
- 13. Hold runner: For 1B2 never! All others always on none or 1 out; also on 2 out unless runner won't steal.
- 14. Infield deep before 6th, on 2 out, if score difference 3 or more, if man on 1st too. Otherwise play in.
- 15. Offensive runner advancement: By Adams tables. **For computer game**, when obvious (runner well around bag, or on single to right with runners on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> and pitcher allows 8's). Consider runner's speed.
- 16. Outfield throws: Never if runner has 33/36 or better chance of safe advance (unless this scores winning run), cutoff automatic, trailing runners hold. Otherwise throw.
- 17. Injuries: Your judgment but see next page. Call: (978)-687-2124 for lineup if needed, just do your best.
- 18. Send runner on 3rd: On 2 out, your infield deep, or your defense below average (sum of 2nd + SS + 3rd basemen less than 19).

19. Defense against multiple steals: Pitch from stretch as appropriate. Hold ball and free steal of 2nd (no steal of home) for men on 1st and 3rd (unless #12 applies); for runners on 1st and 2nd go for lowest SSN.

Closer: 9<sup>th</sup> Albers 1.1 IP per game. Betances can save if Albers needed early or unavailable

Set-up: 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> Betances (not bases loaded) Barnes, Bleier sometimes Strickland

Middle: 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> same as for Set-up but more likely the grades 13 and 14. When behind 4 or more – Seawald.

Lefty specialist: Abad or Bleier

Long: Edgin or Sewald (or Junis when he is in the bullpen.)

MOP – Lowest grade

STARTERS ARE NEVER EVER TO BE USED IN RELIEF (or more than 11.2 IP per start) Exception – September and October Junis will be in the bullpen (not starting). 7 relievers are normally active, see active list and check email for limit on innings later in year. Starters leave when fatigued but protect leads after 5th. Better pitchers should make it to 7<sup>th</sup>. If behind by 3 or more starters may stay until pounded out but leave if GC makes comeback. Junis will be in bullpen Sept. and Oct. for about 30 IP. Sanchez not to be used, until next year (maybe).

## GOTHAM CITY PHILOSPHY THIS YEAR

This team will be a bit above .500 in competition for division lead. I will maximize lineups when I face my division. Games are a little tight so extensive bench use is not available. Carpenter and the catchers have extra games and can swap out and Chirinos might bat for Carpenter vs LHP if he is dh and if you can't swap pitchers. Pirela could bat for Dyson (when he is LF) game-on-line. Only Carpenter and Dyson have really bad shifts (on boards) so that other players just stay in the game. The lineup for starting LHP is pretty much fixed. Rest for players occurs for RHP.

In Case of Injury, use this table - keep defense up.

C - Chirinos and Lucroy and they can substitute for each other (if injury requires catcher goes from dh to C then there is no dh after).

- 1b Zimmerman or Carpenter as 1B3. Try not to use any 1B2 eg. Lucroy, Gyorko, Pirela
- 2b Mostly Kinsler, or Machado. Carpenter qualified
- SS Escobar starts 162 games (Machado for injury).
- 3b Gyorko, some Machado. Can swap if injury but if down a lot at that time consider Schimpf or Carpenter (or Pirela if no other option).
- CF Dyson and Pham but Gentry qualified (when up)
- RF, LF- everybody listed for CF plus Stanton, Pirela (Gyorko only if absolutely necessary) and last month Canha.

Dh - mostly Carpenter or Schimpf.

Some big shifts imply platoons at dh and LF (or CF).

**COMPUTER GAMERS** – As the maximum shift is only (-5) lefty hitters with big board shifts might stay in game with adjusted pitching grade less than 18. In a critical situation (late GC down 1 or tied) consider pinch hitting for weak batters but there will not be much on the bench. Also, for computer gamers, with runners on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> and adjusted pitching grade less than 13 consider having the trailing runner take an extra base on single.
