## OFFENSIVE STRATEGIES

## Hit and Run

Preferred over the straight steal. Baserunners: Lindor, Baez, Galvis, Marisnick. Hitters: Almora, Castro, Ozuna, Castellanos, Galvid and Reddick. If runner has an SSN of 25 or higher after adjustments. 2 to 3 times per game

## Stealing

If the hit and run is not an option, and the runner on first is Lindor, Baez, Galvis, Marisnick or Judge, consider stealing if the SSN is 27 or greater after adjustments, and the score is $+/-2$ runs in $5^{\text {th }}$ or later

## Sacrifice

With bottom 3 in the order, $6^{\text {th }}$ inning later, score 0/-2. Zero outs.

## Pinch-Hitting

When behind by 2 or less, after $6^{\text {th, }}$, consider hitting for the catchers with Almora or Marisnick. Galvis is good choice if hit \& run is a possibility.

## Pinch-Running

For any <8 speed runner, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later, tie or winning run on, less than 2 outs

## Outfield Throws

Always throw for lead runner if chances are $<32$, trailing runner if chances are $<20$, unless lead runner is tie or go ahead, $7^{\text {th }}$ or later.

## Hold Runner on First

Hold all runners regardless of speed.

## Play Infield In

Deep at all times except:

- $\quad 3^{\text {rd }}$ or $2^{\text {nd }} \& 3^{\text {rd }},<2$ outs, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later, tie or winning run on $3^{\text {rd }}$
- Bases full, 0 outs, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later, tie or winning run on $3^{\text {rd }}$


## Defensive Replacements

upgrade defensively by inserting d'Arnaud (and his Th-3) in place of McCann, or any OF-3 for Almora, and shifting Baez to $2^{\text {nd }}$ for Castro,then bringing in Galvis to play $3^{\text {rd }}$.

## PITCHING STRATEGIES

## Managing the Starters

We are on the upswing, marginally, I suppose by having 20 more double digit grade starts than last season, 93 to 73.35 starts come from grade 16 righthanders, which ain't too shabby. That does leave the remaining 69 starts to be assigned to a homer happy 7 (Hellickson), a near innocuous pair Josh Tomlin and Matt Moore, then topped off with 8 starts from a passable 9 (Austin Pruitt). With the exception of the last month, only 1 of the Tomlin/Moore duo will be active each month. One of the lower graded relievers (Jeffress or Grace, then Phelps) should act as caddy to these starters to keep things reasonable and if possible realistic.

## Using the Bullpen

We will begin the season with a 7 -man bullpen. Archie Bradley is our closer/stopper. He can pitch in the $8^{\text {th }}$ for a 5-6 out save, and when the score is tied in $9^{\text {th }}$ or later. Freeman and Ramirez may also close but the role they are best suited is setting up Bradley. Ryan Tepera with his 78 innings is the perfect middle man while Hoby Milner is primarily the situational lefty, but he can go beyond that if more lefthanded batters are due up. Monthly series instructions will list relievers usage remaining for the season.
