NOTES: 1B/C are pure platoon positions even on the computer to start the game. If you bring in a same side pitcher, the other is always available to PH to offset the shift.

PINCH-HITTING: Escobar for the catcher if the game is on the line.
PINCH-RUNNING: Escobar and Herrmann are the two best choices.
HIT \& RUN: This is PRIORITY \#1 for the season, especially with Kemp
STEALS: Only straight steal in the 6th or later with the tying/lead run, SSN 26+.
SACRIFICE: None

BASERUNNING: Master Game: Use Adams Table. Computer game: Use your own judgment.

## DEFENSIVE REPLACEMENTS: NONE

OUTFIELD THROWS: I will trust your judgment here.
INFIELD: The infield will be back unless it is the $8^{\text {th }}$ or later, there are less than 2 outs, and the tying/lead run is on $3^{\text {rd }}$ base and there is no DP possibility.

HOLD: Master Game: Hold if runner has a 26+ chance. Computer Game: Always
STRETCH: Always INTENTIONAL WALK: Only to set up a DP in the $9^{\text {th }}$ or later with a weaker hitter on deck and the game score $+/-1$.

STARTING PITCHING: We still believe that the starters will try to pitch to their fatigue rating, and beyond if things are going well. Do not remove during a shutout; no starter goes more than 10.2 IP

RELIEF PITCHING: We have a lot of depth with this group, and would like to see it utilized to its best potential. No one pitches more than 2.2 innings per outing; no one pitches 3 games in a row.

Closer ( $8^{\text {th }}$ inning on): Parker has the job this year. He is the stopper. He can come into the game in the $8^{\text {th }}$ if necessary.

Middle/Late Relief ( $\mathbf{6}^{\text {th }}$ inning on): Gearrin/Duensing are the setup crew, Tuivailala/Chafin/Pressly are the middle guys. No one goes more than 2.2 IP in any outing.

Mop-up Crew: Duffy will fill the role. He can be used for more than 2.2 IP when necessary to save the pen.
