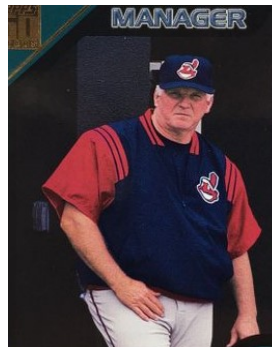

The Lefty/righty usage splits listed above are estimated. As the season progresses, match actual usage against the estimated usage and make the necessary adjustments.

OFFENSIVE STRATEGY

HIT AND RUN: Limited. 7th inning or later, score -2 or tied. **Wendle** or **Villar** on first. **Inciarte** at bat.

STEALING: Limited. 7th inning or later, score -1 or tied, to get the winning or tying run to second.

SSN +25 or better, **Wendle, Villar, J. Iglesias or Inciarte** can attempt a straight steal.
Villar limited to two steals per series. The other three one steal per series. Any steal as a result of a H & R count in series' limits.

PINCH HITTING:

Against a LHP: 8th inning or later, winning or tying run in scoring position, **Grossman** for **Cave** or **Winker**
Against a RHP: Same situation as with a lefty, **Cave** for **Grossman**

PINCH RUNNING:

Villar can come off the bench to pinch run for any base runner not rated "F". When that base runner is in scoring position and represents the winning or tying run. 8th inning or later.

SACRIFICE:

7th inning or later to get winning or tying run in scoring position. And the H & R or straight steal is not an option. Batters: **Martin, Villar, JCY, Cozart, and J. Iglesias** can attempt to sacrifice.

RUNNER ADVANCEMENT:

BOARD GAME: **Adam's Table**

RUNNER ADVANCEMENT:

COMPUTER GAME:

"Well around the bag" ---- send the runner home, and a runner to 3rd if hit is to CF or RF.

If the fielder plays a hit "on the long bounce", Send the runner only if he's fast. Don't send him to 3rd.

On doubles to RF line, send the fast runner home but hold the slow runner. An average speed runner can score if the OF arm is <30.

On well-hit drives to right-center, when bases empty, where the runner "hits 2nd under a full head of steam" --- try for third if he hit any triples (in the real-life MLB season).

On singles to LF, an average or fast runner can score – but no one has a good shot at 3rd. On singles to CF and RF, fast runners have a good shot at 3rd, all runners should try to score.

When the fielder "retreats to get it", send the runner home.

DEFENSIVE STRATEGY

OUTFIELD THROWS:

Throw for the lead runner unless the chances are 34+. Always throw for the tying/go-ahead runner starting in the 7th inning.

COMPUTER GAME: Follow the same principles for throwing at your runners as outlined for my runners.

HOLD RUNNER ON FIRST:

When 1B(4or5) is playing, always hold. Otherwise:

- a) Hold all fast runners.
- b) Hold all average runners unless I have a lead of 2 or more and there is a PR hitter.
- c) Hold slow runners only with a RH hitter or less than 2 out unless I lead by 2 or more.
- d) Do not hold with 2 out and runners on 1st and 3rd unless runner on 1st is the lead or tying run.

PLAYING INFIELD IN:

PLAY 'IN' starting in the 8th inning, 0 or 1 out, tying or go-ahead run on 3rd.

INTENTIONAL WALK:

I only use this on those occasions when a monster hitter comes up with the game on the line. Your call.

PITCH FROM THE STRETCH:

In the 7th or later, score tied, or Indians up 1, with a SB threat on 3B.

DEFENSIVE REPLACEMENT:

9th inning, score Indians +1 to +3. **Wendle for Villar** at 2B. **Cozart** (When Active) for **Andujar** at 3B.

1B **White***

INF **Villar/Martin/Cozart**

C **Whoever is on the bench.**

DH **Best hitter off bench.**

* **If White has to play 1B in an emergency, IND will have to forego the DH.**

COMPUTER NOTES:

1. Not necessary to send the game sheets/scripts for road computer games.
2. Do not use the computer manager function, prefer manual managing for the Indian road computer games.



PITCHING STRATEGY

MANAGING THE STARTERS

Flaherty is the only strater that could finish the season with a winning record. Syndergaard and Porcello will need help from the bull pen, which doesn't exist. So maybe .500. The others will all lose, the only question is by how much.

Flaherty will pitch until he has been fatigued twice.

Syndergaard & Porcello will pitch until fatigued.

Romano & Weaver will attempt to complete a minimum of five innings. Only remove before five innings, if pounded out. At the end of five innings, if the game is winnable, get the game to the bull pen. Winnable is defined as the game is tied, the Indians are winning, or the Indians trail by no more than four runs. If the game is not winnable, leave the starter in until pounded out.

Fedde & Jurado will pitch three innings. If they have not surrendered a run, they will continue to pitch until they give up their first run. If the first run is scored in innings 1-3, or innings 4-5, bring in

M. Moore for 2.7 innings, even if fatigued. After Moore's innings, depending on the score, go to the bull pen. If the first run is scored after the 5th inning, then just go straight to the pen. Moore is limited to 2.7 innings, so he can pitch back to back games in SEP and NOV.

USING THE BULL PEN

Not a lot of innings here, plus what is here is not that good. Nevertheless, we will **pretend** that there is an abundance of quality innings available. We will use the pen until the well runs dry, then it will be throwback baseball to the 19th century when the starters finished what they started. It doesn't really matter, since the pen is not expected to win or preserve many games anyway. Last year's pen was better and it failed 29 times so expectations for this year are low.

GROUP A: **Raisel Iglesias** is still the man in a save situation. When the starter is not going for a complete game. Iglesias can enter the game after two outs in the 8th and earn a 1.1 inning save.

GROUP B/C (CFP): For this season, the set-up group and the middle inning group will be combined. Because our set-up guy is the closer and no one else has the grade to be a set-up guy. So we will throw all these guys into one pot. We will call it pitch this guy and "**Cross Your Fingers Pot**" or **CFP** for short. In alphabetical order this pot includes: **J. Jimenez, J. Minaya, H. Rondon, D. Strckenrider, and D. VerHagen**. They are interchangeable and can pitch any inning 5 thru 8. Pitch until fatigued. **Limit two innings per game each**. Four will active APR-JUN. Three will active JUL-OCT, to make room for **Stumpf**.

GROUP D: Long Reliever and extra innings guy. **C. Martin**. He's innouous. He will pitch when the starter is pounded out and will finish the game. No innings limit. He will pitch extra inning games until the issue

is decided. The exception to using **Martin**, if the game becomes winnable, go to the best pitcher still available in the pen.

THE CADDY: M. Moore. Will be active when **Fedde and Jurado** are scheduled to start. His role is defined in the Managing The Starters section.

THE LOOGY: J. Venters. Doesn't fall into any particular group. He will be active each month. Use him any inning, after the starter has been lifted, and tough hitters are due up with a minus vs. LHP. He can face multiple hitters in one inning. **Limit: Two-thirds inning per game.**
In August when Venters is down, Moore will double as the LOOGY, when not pitching for Fedde.
