### **Offensive Strategies**

#### Hit and Run and Steal

There is very little to work with here. Only two Jets have double digit steal attempts and many of our batters have poor SSNs. We may change this philosophy later, but to start out the season don't worry about employing the hit and run or steal – we'll manage those opportunities in our home games.

Sacrifice with the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> place hitters if the score is tied or we're behind by one run AND there's a runner on 2<sup>nd</sup> base with no out AND it's the 7<sup>th</sup> inning or later

#### Runner Advancement:

Board Game – use Adams Tables

Computer Game – Go when the runner is “well around”, otherwise try to score when  
0 out if (OF Arm – Runner Speed) is less than 15  
1 out if (OF Arm – Runner Speed) is less than 24  
2 out if (OF Arm – Runner Speed) is less than 30

Pinch Running: Look to PR for our catchers if they represent the tying or go-ahead run in the 8<sup>th</sup> inning or later.

Pinch Hitting: On the computer, let the batters play through their shifts. On the boards, pinch-hit for **Ketel Marte** against

**RHRP and Santana and Mullins** if facing a LHRP 7<sup>th</sup> inning or later and we're behind by 3 runs or less. Get the best defense afterward.

### **Defensive Strategies**

Holding Runners on 1<sup>st</sup>: Always

Play Infield in – Three cases

Runner on 3<sup>rd</sup> only, 0 or 1 out, 6<sup>th</sup> or later, Jets +1 to -4

Runners on 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> or later, 0 out, Jets +0 to -4

Runners on 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> or bases loaded, only if winning run is on third, 9<sup>th</sup> inning or later, 0 or 1 out. (1 out, bases full, play infield deep if batter has 2+ 24s on their card)

Intentional Walk:

Pitch from stretch: Always when runners are on base

Outfield Throws: Always throw for the go-ahead run, 8<sup>th</sup> or later. Otherwise-

Board Game – throw for lead runner with less than 33/36 chances, otherwise cut the throw to hold trailing runners.

Computer Game- Always throw for slow lead runner, throw for other runners unless “well around” otherwise cut the throw to hold trailers.

Defensive Replacements: Look to upgrade out outfield defense if we lead after hitting in the 8<sup>th</sup> inning.

**Pitching Strategy** These are **general guidelines**. You have the freedom to make whatever pitching decisions you deem appropriate within the flow of the game. As always, never remove a starter who hasn't allowed an earned run and never let a starter pitch more than 11.7 innings.

**Nola:** Remove if downgraded or fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 7<sup>th</sup> inning or later, score +/- 3 runs.

**Tanaka, Manaea, Boyd, and Le Blanc:** Remove if downgraded/fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 6<sup>th</sup> inning or later, score +/- 3 runs

**Fulmer:** Remove if downgraded/fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 5<sup>th</sup> inning or later, score +/- 3 runs.

### Bullpen:

- The closer is **Brasier (RH 23\*)**. He doesn't have many innings, so he only pitches in save situations and if he loses the lead he comes out immediately.
- Set up roles belong to **Robertson (RH 15\*)**, **Hernandez (RH 15\*)**, and **Rogers (LH 15\*)**. They generally pitch the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> innings in games that we're leading or within a run. Try to matchup them up against your hitters as best you can.
- **Brebbia (RH 12\*)** and **Hudson (RH 11\*)** will fill the middle relief role. They will generally pitch after the starter is removed and we're tied or behind.
- Long relief/ mop-up pitchers will be some combination of **Chen (LH 6)**, **Leake (RH 5)**, **Kintzler (RH 4\*)**, and **Loup (LH 4\*)**. **Chen and Leake do not get the first batter +5 advantage**. Use them if the starter takes a 5 point reduction in the first four innings or if the game is a lost cause (down 6 runs or more after the 6<sup>th</sup>).
- We have three lefty relievers on the roster, two of which will be active most months. Use them strategically against the lefty-challenged part of your lineup.

If anything is unclear, use your best judgment. Good Luck to all-Vic
