Offensive Strategies

Strategy 1: Swing hard

Strategy 2: Hit and Run. Hit and Run with a runner on first when legal using the combinations below. With runners on first and third employ the hit and run with two outs only.

Hitters: **Andrus, Kipnis, Marte, and Votto**

Runners: **Andrus, Kiermaier, Marte, and Santana**

Do not hit and run if your pitcher has a W on the computer or a control rating of -24 or worse on the boards.

Strategy 3 Steal. If the hit and run is not in order, **Andrus, Kiermaier, Marte and Santana** can attempt to steal second base from the 4th inning on if their adjusted SSN is 27 or more, and the score is within 3 runs.

Strategy 4: Sacrifice with the 8th and 9th place hitters if the score is tied or we're behind by one run AND there's a runner on 2nd base with no out AND it's the 7th inning or later

Runner Advancement:

Board Game – use Adams Tables

Computer Game – Go when the runner is “well around”, otherwise try to score when

0 out if (OF Arm – Runner Speed) is less than 15

1 out if (OF Arm – Runner Speed) is less than 24

2 out if (OF Arm – Runner Speed) is less than 30

Pinch Running: There is some speed on the bench with

Kiermaier and Kipnis. Look to PR for our catchers or **Votto** if they represent the tying or go-ahead run in the 8th inning or later.

Pinch Hitting: Pinch-hit for our catchers with **Hoskins or Kiermaier** against a LHRP and **Votto or Hicks** against a RHRP 7th inning or later and we're behind by 3 runs or less.

Defensive Strategies

Holding Runners on 1st: Always

Play Infield in – Three cases

Runner on 3rd only, 0 or 1 out, 6th or later, Jets +1 to -4

Runners on 1st and 3rd, 8th or later, 0 out, Jets +0 to -4

Runners on 2nd and 3rd or bases loaded, only if winning run is on third, 9th inning or later, 0 or 1 out. (1 out, bases full, play infield deep if batter has 2+ 24s on their card)

Intentional Walk:

Pitch from stretch: Always when runners are on base

Outfield Throws: Always throw for the go-ahead run, 8th or later. Otherwise-

Board Game – throw for lead runner with less than 33/36 chances, otherwise cut the throw to hold trailing runners.

Computer Game- Always throw for slow lead runner, throw for other runners unless “well around” otherwise cut the throw to hold trailers.

Defensive Replacements: If we lead after hitting in the 8th inning try to configure the defense as closely as possible to the following - Barnhart (C), Votto (1B), Kipnis (2B), Andrus (SS), Suarez (3B), Marte (LF), Kiermaier (CF), Hicks (RF)

Pitching Strategy These are **general guidelines**. You have the freedom to make whatever pitching decisions you deem appropriate within the flow of the game. As always, never remove a starter who hasn't allowed an earned run and never let a starter pitch more than 11.7 innings.

Starters:

Nola, Waguespack, and Boyd: Remove if downgraded/fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 6th inning or later, score +/- 3 runs

Tanaka, Kelly, and Leake: Remove if downgraded/fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 5th inning or later, score +/- 3 runs.

Bullpen:

- The closer is **Ginkel (RH 23*)**. He doesn't have many innings, so he only pitches in save situations and if he loses the lead he comes out immediately.
- When **Ginkel** is unavailable, the closer role will fall to **Cordero (RH 17*)** who is innings-challenged himself. If he blows the save,

remove him as well. When both **Ginkel and Cordero** are up, Cordero is part of the set up crew.

- Set up roles belong to **Hudson (RH 16*)**, and **Wendelken (RH 16*)**. They generally pitch the 7th and 8th innings in games that we're leading or within a run.
- **Kintzler (RH 14*)**, **Rogers (LH 14*)**, and **Brebbia (RH 13*)** will fill the middle relief role. They will generally pitch after the starter is removed and we're tied or behind.
- Long relief/ mop-up pitchers will be some combination of **Brasier (RH 10*)**, **LeBlanc (LH 8*)**, and **Wisler (RH 5*)**. Use them if the starter takes a 5 point reduction in the first four innings or if the game is a lost cause (down 6 runs or more after the 6th). **LeBlanc** has a lot of innings and a fatigue rating of 22* so use him liberally in these situations.
- We have two lefty relievers on the roster, **Rogers and LeBlanc**, who are scheduled to be active all season. Use them strategically against the lefty-challenged part of your lineup.

If anything is unclear, use your best judgment. Good Luck to all-Vic
