LOTS of good innings in the bullpen, but no TBL-closer-grades. So mix and match to give Munich its best chances in close games and use the mops in games that aren't close late. But, the supreme instruction is (as always): have fun!

## **<u>PITCHING</u>**

**<u>Starters</u>**: Handle them by these principles:

- **deGrom**, **Greinke**, **Ryu** Studly in all respects. Go as deep as possible, until downgraded by fatigue or runs.
- **Darvish** Good grade, but doesn't stop HR's. Mediocre control. Hence, will give way to the bullpen by middle innings unless he is pitching a shutout, in which case he stays until the shutout is gone.
- Hendricks "Only" grade 10, but control and HA say he's a GOOD 10. Try to get 6 IP out of him, but not at the cost of endangering a lead. After that, it's a quick hook at any sign of trouble (unless the game is a blowout, in which case, he can stay in a bit longer rather than waste bullpen but even then, if it starts to get close, go to the relievers).
- Chavez Has to cover 7 starts (unless the waiver wire changes that). Only a 5 (though with good control), so the phrase Quick Hook was invented for him. He may have a caddy; look for series-specific instructions for Oct/Nov. The general rules that apply to all starters: Max of 11.2 IP for any starter.

**<u>Relievers</u>:** Can you say "by committee"? Sure, I knew you could! There's over 500 IP of grade 8\* and up – but no TBL closer grade. SO, you'll have lots of occasions to use the +5, perhaps multiple times in an inning to stop a rally. I don't give a hoot who gets saves, so mix and match as needed to keep your offense under control. There are 6 relievers with grades of 12\* to 15\* who all stop homers – four are active in any given month, so use them as the situation requires, mainly when the game is close or Munich leads. They combine for 381 IP, so you can lean on them. The only set roles are:

Situational Lefty – Two of the three southpaws will be active in all months. They all have enough IP that they don't need to be treated as LOOGY's. But they are all wild, so they may need to yield to a righty before their fatigue.

#### Long/Mop/(and Middle when trailing) -

• Stammen (and after him Chavez may be called up) – lots of IP so you can be generous in using him up to 2.2 IP/game if needed. I'll handle any roster changes that their usage may require.

## **Lineups and Usage**

General – 1. Use these boxes for guidance regarding usage and substitution decisions. (Apply to boards or BBW.)
2. Definitely follow the DEF and BLOWOUT instructions, as I've worded them to account for most/all of the usage handling. All batters will be going by PA; but I can't waste key hitters' PA during blowouts. If you ignore or over-ride these instructions, please leave a note on the scoresheet as to why you did it.

3. CATCHER – Contreras gets 3 PA (*less if it's an early blowout*). At that point if it's tied or Munich trails by 1 or 2 runs, leave him in, else replace him with Avila.

## Offensive Tactics (General Guidance):

#### Hit-and-Run (#1 tactical choice – but very limited this year):

[1] Altuve should hit and run whenever legal and the runner has an adjusted SSN of at least 22.

[2] **Cabrera, Sogard** as batters should hit and run any time they are eligible and the runner on 1<sup>st</sup> has an adjusted SSN of at least 22, *unless* the pitcher's control is -24 or worse ("W" on the computer game). (NOTE – not everyone with two 31's is in this list; this is intentional, please hit and run only with the listed players.)

#### Steal (#2 tactical choice):

There are some good runners, but not a whole lot of attempts. **Eaton, Gomez, Heyward, Meadows, Rizzo, Rojas, Simmons, Sogard** – can straight steal second in the 8<sup>th</sup> or later with an *adjusted* SSN of 26+ when he is the -1/tie/+1/+2 run when Meadows, Rizzo or Schwarber are **not** the batter. (Don't worry about trying to steal third or home.).

#### Bunt (#3 tactical option):

Basically, only in very late innings of a one-run or tie game, to move a man to scoring position when NEITHER the current batter nor the on-deck man have much power (less than 4 power numbers <u>and</u> no first-column 1), AND the steal or hit-and-run are not indicated by the above instructions. Don't squeeze.

#### **Runner Advancement:**

The general guidelines are:

- With runners whose speed is 13 or more be responsibly aggressive, especially when heading home, and especially with two out. (The term is "aggressive", though, not "stupid" I don't want even a fast runner to go home on 6 chances, or a slow/average runner to try going first to third on a single to left, for example....)
- With slow runners, be content to play station to station, unless the hit is so deep that the chance is 30+ and it makes sense in game terms.
- With average runners whose speed is 12 or less, use your judgment based on the game situation. But don't be overly aggressive and take the bat away from a big hitter (anyone with first-column 1, or four or more power numbers).
- Have fast trailing runners try to advance if you throw for the leading runner; do not have slow trailing

runners try to advance.

• <u>Computer gamers</u>: always send my runner home if he is "well around" third. Send a runner who is "well around" second on to third IF Munich LEADS or is TIED, with 0 or 1 out. Never send a runner who is "rounding" the base. Don't have anyone try for the triple when that choice is given. Otherwise, be aggressive with fast runners when the game is within 3 runs.

Infield In; Outfield Throws; Hold Runners – Use your best baseball judgment and common sense.

### **Injury Subs:**

- C Contreras (offense); Avila (defense); Caratini when active
- 1B practically everyone has a carded rating at 1B, so if Rizzo gets hurt, use the most logical option
- 2B Altuve, Sogard, Zobrist, Rojas, Turner
- 3B-Turner, Sogard, Zobrist, Caratini if active, Altuve (as a 4)
- SS Simmons, Sogard, Zobrist (and note that Altuve can play SS under the TBL infield rules as SS-6)

OF – prefer an OF-3 if Munich is tied or leading, Zobrist, Meadows, Rojas; Schwarber as last resort

DH – available bat; let pitcher hit in blowout
