OFFENSIVE STRATEGY
HIT AND RUN: DO IT! Starting in the 6th inning, score IND -2 to +1, less than two outs, with Grisham,
Hampson, Robert, Villar, or Wendle on 1st and Iglesias, Olivares, Pujols, or Wendle At Bat. Same game situation, any two of the above runners on 1 st and 3 rd and one of the above batters AT Bat. Yep we're gonna do it, 1st and 3rd Hit \& Run. Why not? We ain't winning anyway.

STEALING: It has been two to three years since IND has stolen a base in a road game. The goal this season is to change that. Since we won't win many games, may as well insert some fun into the festivities. Game situation and score are the same as with the hit and run. Same designated runners on base. A non hit and run batter at the plate.
Straight steal second.
Straight steal third with a right handed batter at the plate.
Double \& Triple Steals Yep we're gonna do this too! Same rational as Hit \& Run.
1st \& 2nd Only with a right handed hitter at bat.
2nd \& 3rd Only with a right handed hitter at bat.
1st \& 3rd
Bases Full Admittedly, this may not happen very often. To get three of the designated runners on base all at once. But how much fun will it be, if it does happen! To nullify attempted steals of home, the pitcher has to pitch from the stretch. Don't forget to make the two point deduction to the pitcher's grade.
Designated runners are limited to TWO stolen base attempts (hit \& run or straight steal) per series.

Against a LHP: 8th inning or later, winning or tying run in scoring position, JCJ or Andujar for Winker, Castro, or Hampson.
Against a RHP: Same situation as with a lefty, Winker for Jones and Hampson for Andujar.

## PINCH RUNNING:

Mendick or M. Freeman can come off the bench to pinch run for any base runner rated"S". When that base runner is in scoring position and represents the winning or tying run. 8th inning or later. Mendick will replace Hampson or Villar at 2B or Villar if he is at SS.

SACRIFICE:
7th inning or later to get winning or tying run in scoring position. And the $H \& R$ or straight steal is not an option. Batters: Barnes, Hampson, Villar, M. Freeman or Mendick can attempt to sacrifice.

## RUNNER ADVANCEMENT:

## COMPUTER GAME:


"Well around the bag" ---- send the runner home, and a runner to 3rd if hit is to CF or RF.
If the fielder plays a hit "on the long bounce" ,Send the runner only if he's fast. Don't send him to 3rd. On doubles to RF line, send the fast runner home but hold the slow runner. An average speed runner can score if the OF arm is <30.
On well-hit drives to right-center, when bases empty, where the runner "hits 2 nd under a full head of steam" --- try for third if he hit any triples (in the real-life MLB season).
On singles to LF, an average or fast runner can score - but no one has a good shot at 3rd. On singles to CF and RF, fast runners have a good shot at 3rd, all runners should try to score.
When the fielder "retreats to get it", send the runner home.

## DEFENSIVE SIRAIEGY

## OUTFIELD THROWS:

Throw for the lead runner unless the chances are 34+. Always throw for the tying/go-ahead runner starting in the 7th inning.
COMPUTER GAME: Follow the same principles for throwing at your runners as outlined for my runners.
HOLD RUNNER ON FIRST:
When $1 \mathrm{~B}(4 \mathrm{or} 5)$ is playing, always hold. Otherwise:
a) Hold all fast runners.
b) Hold all average runners unless I have a lead of 2 or more and there is a PR hitter.
c) Hold slow runners only with a RH hitter or less than 2 out unless I lead by 2 or more.
d) Do not hold with 2 out and runners on 1st and 3rd unless runner on 1st is the lead or tying run.

PLAYING INFIELD IN:
PLAY 'IN' starting in the 8th inning, 0 or 1 out, tying or go-ahead run on 3rd.
INTENTIONAL WALK:
I only use this on those occasions when a monster hitter comes up with the game on the line. Your call. PITCH FROM THE STRETCH:
Don't. We will take our chances throwing out the runner.
DEFENSIVE REPLACEMENT:
9th inning, score Indians +1 to +3 . Do in priority listed.

1. Mendick for Villar if Villar is at SS
2. Mendick for Villar if Villar is at 2B.
3. Mendick for Hampson if Hampson is at 2B.
4. Hedges for whatever catcher is playing.

INJURY/Ejection SUBS:
1B M. Freeman if he is active; otherwise Pujols (Have to play w/o the DH)
INF Mendick, Villar, Hampson, \& Wendle
C Whomever is on the bench.


OF Whomever is on the bench.
DH Best hitter off bench.

1. Not necessary to send the game sheets/scripts for road computer games.
2. Do not use the computer manager function, prefer manual managing for the Indian road computer games.

PIICHING SIRAIEGY
MANAGING THE STARTERS
IND's strating rotation is made up of a bunch of guys. Syndergaard continues his pattern of only pitching every other season. So this year he sits out. Flaherty was drafted to be an ace, but this season he is just a guy. Antone and Houck have ace grades, but in-reality, they are just guys. How to play our guys:
Antone and Houck will pitch until fatigued twice.
Flaherty, Fleming, Peterson, and Shoemaker will pitch until fatigued.
Lugo and Montas will attempt to complete a minimum of five innings. Only remove before five innings, if pounded out. At the end of five innings, if the game is winnable, get the game to the bull pen. Winnable is defined as the game is tied, the Indians are winning, or the Indians trail by no more than three runs.
If the game is not winnable, leave them in until pounded out. If by some miracle, they are throwing a shutout, of course leave them in.
Porcello's will pitch three innings unless pounded out. At the end of three innings, if he has not allowed a run, he will continue to pitch until he gives up his first run. After three innings, if he allowed a run, go to Brent Suter. Suter will pitch three innings. After Suter's innings, depending on the score, go to the bull pen.
If Porcello gives up his first run in the fourth or fifth inning, still go to Suter for his three innings. USING THE BULL PEN
GROUP A: Antone will open the season as a starter. When he finishes his 11 starts, he will assume the closer role. Until then, P. Johnson will serve as the closer, when the starter is not going for a complete game. As if that will ever happen.
GROUP B: The lefty/ righty set-up guys. They will pitch the 7th and 8th innings to get to a save situatuon. They are: P. Fairbanks, J. Rodriguez and, J. Staumont. D. Peterson will join this group when he has finished his starts. P. Johnson will join this group when Antone becomes the closer. Two will be active each month. GROUP C: The middlemen. D. Bard and C. Quantrill. Available to pitch the 5th and/or the 6th innings when the starter is fatigued early, or for the back end rotation guys. When they come out after five innings. J. Fleming will join this group when he has finished his starts. Two will be active each month. GROUP D: Long Reliever and extra innings guys. J. Holder and S. Lugo. Holder is innocuous. He will pitch when the starter is pounded out and will finish the game. No innings limit. He will pitch extra inning games until the issue is decided. The exception to using Holder, if the game becomes winnable, go to the best pitcher still available in the pen. Lugo will start the season in this role until he has used his 29 innings of relief. If we run out of innings, then Phelps will finish out the season.
THE CADDY: B. Suter. Will be active to caddy Porcello's starts. His role is defined in the Managinging The Starters section.
THE LOOGY: A. Claudio. Use him any inning, after the starter has been lifted, and tough hitters are due up with a minus vs. LHP. He can face multiple hitters in one inning. Limit: One inning per game.
