## **OFFENSIVE STRATEGIES**

### Hit and Run

Lots of hitters that qualify with the required number of 31's, but propensity for striking out make them poor choices to execute a hit and run. The overall lack of steal attempts make the hit & run a very limited option for this offense. Lindor, Myers, and Brosseau are the best we have as base runners, while the hitters are the Josh Naylor/Donovan Solano types with decent contact.

### Stealing

This has even more limits than the hit & run. Only 2 plays with over 10 attempts, and one of them will be inactive the majority of the year. That leaves Lindor and he should only attempt a steal in 7<sup>th</sup> or later score tied or we are down by 1, any number of outs, SSN of 28 or better.

### Sacrifice

With the 8 or 9 hitter, 0 outs, runners on first, or first and second, score tied or we trail by 1.

### Pinch-Hitting

This crazy abbreviated schedule of 60 games produced some problematic shifts for us. Hitting righties, especially on the boards is an area that went unaddressed in the offseason and the draft. Some of the more severely penalized hitters against RHP, Castro, Gosselin, McCann, and Brosseau, may have to be pinch hit for late in close games. Use Marisnick as primary pinch hitter, then sub him in the outfield for any OF-2 not named Myers.

### Pinch-Running

For any slow or near slow runner (Naylor, Romine, McCann, Bell), late in close games

### Runner Advancement

As you would your team. I find myself leaning more on the Adams tables rather than gut feeling to make those decisions. You can use what ever method you are most comfortable with.

## **DEFENSIVE STRATEGIES**

### Outfield Throws

Always throw for lead runner if chances are <32, trailing runner if chances are <20, unless lead runner is tie or go ahead, 7<sup>th</sup> or later.

### Hold Runner on First

Hold all runners regardless of speed.

### Play Infield In

Deep at all times except:

- 3<sup>rd</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>, <2 outs, 8<sup>th</sup> or later, tie or winning run on 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Bases full, 0 outs, 8<sup>th</sup> or later, tie or winning run on 3<sup>rd</sup>

## Defensive Replacements

Galvis to 2<sup>nd</sup> , Marisnick for Reddick, Naylor, or Castellanos, Gosselin at 3<sup>rd</sup> to protect a 3 run lead or less after the 7<sup>th</sup>.

## PITCHING STRATEGIES

Trevor Bauer was brought in to help us secure a playoff spot and possibly win a division. Shane Bieber, a Bauer clone, along with Kenta Maeda form the upper half of the rotation. After that, things get a little shaky. Daniel Ponce de Leon does contribute 22 starts as a 14, but his peripherals need to shut up. Journeyman Trevor Cahill (the middle of 3 Trevor starters) chips in with 16 starts as a wild 18 with near opener length fatigue. 8 starts of Yonny Chirinos as a decent 9 round out the usable portion of the starters. That unfortunately leaves 24 starts to be the responsibility of a pair of 1's: Trevor Richards (19 st) and Carlos Rodon (5 st). These 2 will more than likely have an assigned caddy.

In the bullpen, Devin Williams was drafted to take some load off Liam Hendriks. One can set up the other as closer. Hendriks might be preferred to come in with men on base 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> with Williams working the 9<sup>th</sup>. The remainder of the relief corp fall in the 11-13 range with the exception of Evan Phillips whose role it appears will be to caddy for the grade 1's or any starter knocked out early. The lone lefty reliever is Aaron Bummer, whose middling grade 9, for all of 26 innings, does come equipped with a +62 against the HR offset by his -54 walk rating. His role, when active, will be the one out lefty type.
