The 2021 Northboro Phoenix

Northboro plays the Board Game. Please don't use micro managers. Please send game sheets and scripts.

Expectations are high in Northboro. This year's edition of the Phoenix is exciting. We can hit well, we can pitch well, and we hope that will be enough to overcome some defensive weaknesses.

Generally the starters will play the whole game. There will be enough flexibility to make one or two late, close game strategy moves – pinch running for slow guys, pinch hitting for unfavorable shifts, defensive substitutions in the infield.

We will ALWAYS send out lineups and roster changes at the beginning of the month. If you don't get a mailing by the second day of the month, please contact Steve.

Player-by-Player Usage

We have sufficient roster slack that there will always be a useful bench for late inning strategic moves.

Strategies on Offense

Steal: (of second with 0,1,2 out; of third with 1 out) When we are behind by one or tied, and advised by Adams tables, steal with **Hernandez, Profar** or **Swanson** from the 8th inning on.

Hit and Run: The monthly lineups will indicate when to H&R against the particular starting pitcher. Otherwise, Check Steal before H&R, then,

With **Yandy Diaz** at bat with a runner on first or runners on first and third and 0 or 1 out, H&R when the runner on first is not slow and the adjusted SSN is 10 or more.

With **Ramon Laureano** at bat with a runner on first or runners on first and third and 0 or 1 out, H&R when the runner on first is not slow and the adjusted SSN is 18 or more.

With **Aledmyz Diaz** at bat, do not hit and run with runners on first and third. Hit and run with a runner on first when when the runner on first is not slow and the adjusted SSN is 18 or more.

Do not hit and run with **Teoscar Hernandez** at bat.

Otherwise, hit and run with runner on first or runners on first and third with any legal batter (including with 2 outs for **Laureano** and **Yandy Diaz**) and **Laureano, Hernandez, Profar** or **Swanson** on first. Exception: Don't hit and run with 1st and 3rd against a drawn-in infield.

Sacrifice: down by one or tied, 7th inning or later, no out, runner on second or runners on first and second, 8th-9th in the batting order at bat.

Runner advancement: use Adams tables. On computer game, go when “well around”, but play safe with slow runners and fewer than 2 outs.

Pinch Hitting: Very occasionally. Monthly instructions will have more detail.

Pinch Running: Consider pinch-running for catchers or **Aguilar** in the 8th inning or later with **Profar** when they represent the tying or winning run. Monthly instructions will have more detail.

Strategies for Defense

Hold runner on first: If the firstbaseman is 1B-4 or better, hold the runner. Otherwise, if the batter is PL, hold the runner. Otherwise, only hold runners with an adjusted SSN of 23 or more.

Infield in: Never with 2 out. Never before the 7th inning. Otherwise, play in if we are between 2 runs down to 1 run ahead.

Pitch from the Stretch: if the runner on third has 10 or more chances to steal home, and we are between 2 runs down to 1 run ahead, pitch from the stretch.

Throw for runners: Always throw to get the runner representing the go ahead or lead run after the 5th inning. Otherwise:

- on the boards, throw for the lead runner if the chance is 32 or less, otherwise throw for the second runner.

- in the Computer game, throw for the lead runner if he is slow, or unless the runner “well around”; otherwise throw for the second runner.

Defensive replacements: ahead by 1 to 3 runs after we bat in the 7th – **Gyorko** at 3B, **Gonzalez** replacing **Dietrich** at 2B or replacing **Aguilar** at 1B. If both **Dietrich** and **Aguilar** are in the lineup, and **Profar** is playing OF, and there’s an available OF sub, move **Profar** to the infield and sub the OFer for **Dietrich**.

The Pitching Staff and Pitching Strategies

There are three kinds of starters in Northboro – really good ones, pretty good ones, and openers. The fatigue factors are pretty low throughout the starting staff. We certainly want starters to go at least 5 innings, and sometimes into the seventh or later.

The really good ones are **Dakota Hudson**, **Ian Anderson**, and **Kyle Cody**. Replace these guys when they are reduced for the second time.

The pretty good ones are **Justin Dunn**, **Garrett Richards**, **Antonio Senzatela**, and **Daniel Castano**. Replace these guys when they are fatigued.

There are 8 starts of openers. **Matt Foster** has 5 as a grade 21 – let him stay until the second reduction, **Caleb Ferguson** has 3 as a grade 13 lefty – replace him after one fatigue reduction. **Castano** and **Richards** will spend their relief innings caddying for these guys, hopefully getting us to the 6th inning.

- Never let a starter go more than 11 2/3 innings.

- Other than that, never remove a starter pitching a shutout.

- If a starter is reduced by giving up 5 runs in 3 innings, go to the “bad” starters strategy above - if we’re down by 4 or more, leave him in until pounded out. Otherwise go to the pen if he’s under grade 8.

In the bullpen

There are 3 closer grades in the bullpen who should handle the 8th and 9th innings of games we’re tied or ahead by 3 or fewer runs. The closer is **Matt Foster**. The setup guys are **James Karinchak** and **Eric Yardley**. We have several “good” relievers – righties **Noe Ramirez**, **Cody Stashak**, and **Geoff Hartlieb**, and lefties **Caleb Ferguson** and **Jace Fry**. Then we have the mop cabinet – **Ryan Thompson** and **Tyler Chatwood** will be the main mops. **Adam Cimber** and **Jose Alvarado** (an XC) may also see action.
