Newman and Paredes will be very limited in use. The individual series instructions I send will address their strategy/role usage if they are playing.

<u>OFFENSIVE STRATEGY</u>

HIT & RUN: Strategy #1 (Mondesi & Lopes steal attempts become the #1 strategy over the Hit & Run)

- 1) Arenado, Dubon, Frazier, Garcia, Guerrero, Gurriel, Peralta, and Plawecki will H&R with a runner *ONLY on 1st* who has an adjusted SSN of 20 or more & is NOT slow,
- 2) Do not H&R with runners on 1st & 3rd,
- 3) *Computer players* if there are 2 outs, H&R only if Lopes or Mondesi are on 1st.

STEAL: Strategy #2

- 1) Mondesi and Lopes can steal 2nd & 3rd when eligible by Adams Tables. They can steal home from 7th on if they are the lead run and there are 2 outs.
- **2)** If no H&R to be used and eligible by the Adams Tables, Arozarena and Bichette can steal 2nd or 3rd from the 5th on if score STM +2 to -1. They can steal home from 8th on if lead run and 2 outs.

SACRIFICE: Strategy #3

1) Frazier, Gurriel, Newman, and Paredes will sacrifice runner from 2nd to 3rd **OR** 1st and 2nd to 2nd and 3rd in the 5th or later, 0 or 1 out, and their large shift is detrimental to their hit numbers.

PINCH HITTING / PINCH RUNNING: See Strategy/Roles chart above.

RUNNER ADVANCEMENT:

- **1)** Always go if chance is 28+ for home and 32+ for 3B. Otherwise, use Adams Tables.
- 2) *Computer game -* use the standards for advancement that you use for your team.

SEND RUNNER ON 3RD:

1) If your infield is in, HOLD runner unless combined fielding rating of your 2B & SS is < 15.



<u>DEFENSIVE STRATEGY</u>

DEFENSIVE REPLACEMENTS: See Strategy/Roles chart above.

HOLD / DON'T HOLD RUNNER:

1) Hold all runners.

INFIELD IN:

- 1) Runner on 3rd only: 0 or 1 out, 4th inning or later, STM +1 to -2,
- 2) Runners on 1st and 3rd: 6th inning or later, 0 out, STM +1 to -2,
- 3) 2nd & 3rd OR Bases Full: only if winning run at 3rd, 9th inning or later, 0 or 1 out.
 - **EXCEPTION** with 1 out, Bases Full, play deep if batter has 3 or more 24s.

OUTFIELD THROWS:

- **1)** Throw for lead runner if < 33 chances otherwise hold trailing runners.
- 2) In 6th inning or later, hold trailing runner if they are tying run UNLESS lead runner has <16 chances.
- 3) *Computer game -* use standards for throws that you use for your team.

INTENTIONAL WALKS: If lead run is in scoring position after 4th inning & 1B open, issue free pass with:

- 1) 1 out to set up the double play unless on-deck hitter is superior to player to be walked.
- 2) 2 out to get to a much more inferior hitter.
- 3) NEVER walk the bases full.

<u>PITCH FROM THE STRETCH</u>: Runner on 3rd, 5th inning or later, 2 outs, STM +1 to -1, and adjusted SSN > 10.

<u>MANAGING THE PITCHING STAFF</u>

STARTERS: Your gut feeling & first-hand knowledge of the situation is always a trusted guide to help us win on the road. The "mostly" rigid rules I try to follow are:

1) Starters except for Fiers (see 3 below) should NOT be removed

- a. before 5th unless pounded out **OR**
- b. if they are pitching a shutout (UNLESS #2d below occurs).
- 2) All starters should be removed
 - a. after 11.7 innings pitched, **OR**
 - b. in 5th if they fatigue **AND** either surrender a run or allow a runner to get into scoring position with the score STM+3 to -2, **OR**
 - c. from the 6th on if they fatigue, surrender a run, or runner gets on base, STM +4 to -3, **OR**
 - d. if they are less than Grade 20 and the tying run reaches from the 8th on.

3) Fiers should be removed after the 3rd if he has given up 4 runs and the score is within 3 either way.

BULLPEN: Use all the pitchers you need to stop you from scoring and to keep the game close. With 8+ pitchers in the pen every month, I expect very few games where someone Grade 13 and above pitches over an inning. Use the RIP LEFT on the attached roster sheet to determine how much use, on average, they should each receive. Never use anyone over 2.7 unless in extra innings.

<u>CLOSER</u>: Zimmer. He comes in (1) to start the 9th in a save situation (2) during the 9th if a save situation develops.

<u>SET-UP:</u> Rosenthal and Pomeranz are the guys here though Rosenthal can come in as early as the 7th to squelch a rally.

MIDDLE to LATE: All others.

<u>EARLY to MIDDLE</u>: Alexander, Norris and Romo. These three will be the first guys in for Fiers.

<u>GENERAL NOTES</u>: We will play the boards at home. I will send out specific instructions for each road series. Please do not use a computer manager for me. No need for scripts from computer managers, just the stats for both teams.
