2022 Brobdingnag Barbarians Emergency Instructions

The Basics

- Brobdingnag play the boards in 2022.
- We will send out monthly lineups.
- Scoresheets are **not** necessary for computer managers.
- We are in a serious race with KNX, WHI, and STM. We will worry less about relief innings and bench use than we normally do. This might change mid season. Swindel and Sadler are still scarce precious commodities not to be used lightly.
- I trust your judgement to override my instructions when the instructions don't fit the reality of a particular situation.

Monthly Rosters

- The offense is good, not great
- The pitching staff is the strength of this team. We will have 7 relievers up each month. The "typical" game will use 4 to 6 relievers.
- Using the relievers effectively will be the key to winning this year.
- We will have 14 hitters. Platoons at C & 2B, 3 defensive subs, and a PR.
- Acuna and Swindell will share one roster spot.

Roster Cuts

- Carded: Norris, Teheran, Harris, Romero.
- Uncarded: Bashlor, Guerra.

Defensive subs: If we lead after we hit in the 7th, Straw for Nimmo (or Soto), Rodgers to 2B, Zimmerman to 1B, and Maldonado to C. *Use your judgement to move +/- one inning based upon the score & where we are in the batting order.*

- **Pinch Runner:** Straw, and sometimes Nimmo, for any runner speed < 10 who is the tie/winning
- **Pinch Hitter:** The catchers can hit for each other if your pitcher changes. If we trail in the 7th+, tie/win run on base or at bat, Narvaez or Kelly will occasionally PH for Garcia.

Defensive Tactics

Generally:

- If the score is +3/-3 hold all runners who have an adjusted chance to steal of 20+, don't hold the others.
- Pitch from the stretch only if tie/win run is on 3rd in 7th inning+ and 2 out.
- Play deep unless tie/win run is on 3rd with 0/1 out, 7th inning+.
- For IBB, dropped fouls, etc., play it as you would your team.

But use your judgement to override any of this if you think it is in my best interest.

The Offense

- This is not a usual contending offense for a Barbarian team. The OBP is still good, but there are fewer steals than would be normal. The power is OK by 2022 standards, but not exceptional.
- With the reduction in SBAs and increase in 13s & 14s we will **H&R** a bit less, and have to take a few more chances other places. Takes priority over steal.

WHEN: +2/-2, 5th inn +, adjusted SSN 24+. Runner on 1B only.

ON BASE: Acuna, Machado, Straw

HITTERS: Machado, Narvaez, Schwindel

- Steal.** **WHEN:** score 0/-1, 8th inn +, adjusted SSN 26+. Steal 2B only.
ON BASE: same as for H&R.

- Sacrifice.** Third priority.
WHEN: score 0/-1, 8th inn +. Runner on 1B, 2B, 1B & 2B, 0 outs.
HITTERS: Any 7th-9th place hitter who makes the pitcher Gd 18+.
- Baserunning.** If you use the Adams tables for you, you can use them for me. If you don't then be aggressive.

Substitutes

The players on the bench will be plate appearance limited, so they can all be used as needed **except** for **Schwindel**. If you are using the emergency instructions, do not use him off the bench.

In case of injuries/ejections, there are plenty of options. Nimmo & Straw in the OF, Zimmerman at 1B, Rodgers across the INF with Garcia to 2B if needed.

Pitching

If the team is going to fulfil expectations this season, the use of the relief staff will be vital. When/who to use in relief is always the hardest thing to manage for a visiting team, so please read this section for the philosophy and guidelines, then apply them with your best judgement. We will have 7 relievers each month, and a mix of LH & RH as well as a mix of 2 (or 3) closers and the rest solid set-up guys. They have over 650 innings of grade 10+, most 13+. There is no reason to be timid using the relief staff. Once the starter is pulled I expect 3 to 6 relievers will get in the game, typically for 1.3 IP each or less. ***If the game is close*** I will usually bring in the next guy to get the +5 when the next batter reaches base unless keeping the current pitcher in the game is a more favorable matchup for my team.

Starters

GROUP A: Glasnow, Suarez, Buehler & Woodruff. Remove if:

- **Innings 1-4:** If fatigued unless either team leads by 7 or more runs.
- **Innings 5-6:**
 - If fatigued unless either team leads by 7 or more runs
 - **Or** if under Gd 18 and the tie/win run gets on base and the starter isn't a Gd 18+ to the next batter
 - **Or** If under Gd 18 and the score is +5/-5 and two runners get on
- **Inning 7+:**
 - If fatigued unless either team leads by 5 or more runs
 - **Or** if the score is +4/-3 and any runner gets on base.

GROUP B: All starters grades 10-13. Remove:

- **Innings 1-5:** If fatigued unless either team leads by 7 or more runs.
- **Innings 6+:**
 - If fatigued unless either team leads by 5 or more runs
 - **Or** if the score is +4/-3 and any runner gets on base.

GROUP C: Yarborough. Remove:

- **Innings 1-3:**
 - If fatigued
 - **Or** if the score is +4/-3 and two runner gets on base.
- **Innings 4+:**
 - If the score is within 6 runs either way and any runner gets on base.

Relievers

CLOSERS: I believe that closers are intended to get out of threatening situations, and that a typical game has 2 or 3 of those for each team. We will have 2 to 4 closer quality relievers up each month. They should only pitch in two situations:

- In 5th+ inning in games that are +3 to -3 when you have two men on. In these cases they finish the inning (or you get ahead by 4+ runs). They do not start the next inning.
- To start the 9th + inning when I lead by 1 or 2. If they blow the save they come out.
- **Sadler, Kimbrel, Suarez, & vs LHers Brentz** are the closers. Spread the innings please.

OTHER RELIEVERS: The rest of the relief staff. They typically pitch in those relief situations that do not justify a closer. After a closer ends an inning, one of the others starts the next inning. They will typically get pulled after a batter reaches base unless we are already 4 + relievers into the game. Again, spread the wealth, try to avoid 2+ inning appearances. EXCEPTION: If Yarborough or another starter is pulled early, the first one, or even two relievers can go 2.7 innings.

NOTES:

- There is nothing wrong with using a reliever three straight games if the series dictates it, but try not to have more than 1 or 2 relievers ineligible for the next day.
- Sadler should **NEVER** be the last man standing in an extra inning game. With 7 relievers there should **ALWAYS** be a reliever saved to replace Sadler if he blows the save and the game goes to the next inning.
