That translates into "win a few, lose a few." May be a wild card, may be not. Certainly better than gloom and doom, but most likely not champagne and roses. The theme for this season will be "roll with the punches." "Let's get this party started" and let the "chips fall where they may." "It's all about the team." Mercifully I'm out of cliches.

The Indians will play the board game at home.

Use these batting orders if I am unable to play the games for a particular month. Starting in August, you will need to check usage and the inactive roll. Adjust these batting orders as necessary. I will send out monthly batting orders and an updated roster.



OFFENSIVE STRATEGY

HIT AND RUN: DO IT! Starting in the 6th inning, score IND -2 to tie, less than two outs, with Grisham, Hampson, Villar, or Wendle on 1st and Duffy, Hampson, or Iglesias. At Bat. Same game situation, any two of the above runners on 1st and 3rd and one of the above batters AT Bat. Hit and Run.

STEALING: Game situation and score are the same as with the hit and run. Same designated runners on first base and a non hit and run batter at the plate. Straight steal second. All designated runners are limited to one steal attempt per series. This includes attempted steals from Hit and Run.

PINCH HITTING:

Against a LHP: 8th inning or later, winning or tying run in scoring position, Pujols for Winker, Castro, or Wendle.

Against a RHP: Same game situation as with a lefty, Tellez for Pujols.

PINCH RUNNING:

Mendick or L. Robert can come off the bench to pinch run for any base runner rated "S". When that base runner is in scoring position and represents the winning or tying run. 8th inning or later. Mendick will stay in the games per the defensive replacement chart.

SACRIFICE:

7th inning or later to get winning or tying run in scoring position. And the H & R or straight steal is not an option. Batters: Barnes, Hampson, or Mendick can attempt to sacrifice.

RUNNER ADVANCEMENT:

BOARD GAME: Adam's Table

RUNNER ADVANCEMENT:

COMPUTER GAME:

"Well around the bag" ---- send the runner home, and a runner to 3rd if hit is to CF or RF.



If the fielder plays a hit "on the long bounce" ,Send the runner only if he's fast. Don't send him to 3rd.
On doubles to RF line, send the fast runner home but hold the slow runner. An average speed runner can score if the OF arm is <30.
On well-hit drives to right-center, when bases empty, where the runner "hits 2nd under a full head of steam" --- try for third if he hit any triples (in the real-life MLB season).
On singles to LF, an average or fast runner can score – but no one has a good shot at 3rd. On singles to CF and RF, fast runners have a good shot at 3rd, all runners should try to score.
When the fielder "retreats to get it", send the runner home.

DEFENSIVE STRATEGY

OUTFIELD THROWS:

Throw for the lead runner unless the chances are 34+. Always throw for the tying/go-ahead runner starting in the 7th inning.

COMPUTER GAME: Follow the same principles for throwing at your runners as outlined for my runners.

HOLD RUNNER ON FIRST:

When 1B(4or5) is playing, always hold. Otherwise:

- Hold all fast runners.
- Hold all average runners unless I have a lead of 2 or more and there is a PR hitter.
- Hold slow runners only with a RH hitter or less than 2 out unless I lead by 2 or more.
- Do not hold with 2 out and runners on 1st and 3rd unless runner on 1st is the lead or tying run.

PLAYING INFIELD IN:

PLAY 'IN' starting in the 8th inning, 0 or 1 out, tying or go-ahead run on 3rd.

INTENTIONAL WALK:

I only use this on those occasions when a monster hitter comes up with the game on the line. Your call.

PITCH FROM THE STRETCH:

Don't. We will take our chances throwing out the runner.

DEFENSIVE REPLACEMENT:

9th inning, score Indians +1 to +3. Do in priority listed.

- Mendick** for Villar if Villar is at 2B
- Mendick** for Duffy if Duffy is at 3B

Villar has the priority.

INJURY/Ejection SUBS:

- 1B Pujols or Tellez, whomever is not the DH
- INF Mendick, Villar, Hampson, & Wendle
- C Whomever is on the bench.
- OF Whomever is on the bench.
- DH Best hitter off bench.

COMPUTER NOTES:

- Not necessary to send the game sheets/scripts for road computer games.
- Do not use the computer manager function, prefer manual managing for the Indian road computer games.



PITCHING STRATEGY

MANAGING THE STARTERS

Berrios, Flaherty, Montas, Quantrill, and Walker will start 130 games. They will all pitch until fatigued twice. Then go to the pen to finish the game. The remaining 32 games will be started by a combination of starters and openers. General guidance for those guys is outlined below:

Peterson: Will start 15 games. He will pitch until fatigued. If before the 5th inning, put in **Paddack** for two innings. Then go to the pen to finish the game. If after the 5th inning, then just go to the pen.

Paddack: Will start 12 games. He will pitch 3 innings no matter fatigue or score. He will have three caddies; **Suter, Fleming, or Mantiply**. My monthly instructions will specify which to use. The caddie will pitch 3 innings no matter the score. At the end of his innings, go to the pen to finish the game.

Suter: Will pitch the second game of the double hitter. He will pitch until fatigued. If fatigued before the 5th inning, use **Colome** for 2 innings. Then go to the pen to finish the game.

Coonrod: Will open two games. He will pitch 2 innings. **Quantrill** will then pitch 4 innings. Then go to the pen to finish the game.

Fleming: Will open two games. He will pitch 3 innings no matter fatigue or score. After his innings, use **Colome** for 2 innings. Then go to the pen to finish the game.

USING THE BULL PEN

CLOSER: *Doval, Quantrill, and Johnson* will serve as the CLOSER during the months listed below. They will **only** pitch the 9th inning in a save situation, when the starter is not going for a complete game.

APR-JUL: **Doval**
AUG: **Johnson**
SEP-OCT: **Quantrill**
NOV: **Johnson**

SETUP GUYS: They will pitch the 7th and 8th innings to get to a save situation. The setup role will vary from month to month because of caddies and openers. The setup guys by month are listed below:

APR-JUN: **Johnson, Suter, and Tapia.**
JULY: **Fairbanks, Suter, and Wick.**
AUG: **Suter and Tapia**
SEP: **Johnson, Suter, and Tapia**
OCT: **Johnson, Suter, and Wick**
NOV: **Fairbanks**

All setup pitchers are limited to 3 innings per series.

MIDDLEMEN: Available to pitch the 5th and/or the 6th innings when the starter is fatigued early, and does not have a caddy. Like the setup guys, the middlemen will vary by month. The middlemen by month are:

APR-JUN: **Colome and Fairbanks**
JULY: **Colome and Coonrod**
AUG: **Colome, Coonrod, Fleming, and Mantiplay**
SEP-OCT: **Colome, Coonrod, and Mantiplay**
NOV: **Mantiplay**

All middle relievers are limited to 3 innings per series.

LONG RELIEVER/EXTRA INNINGS: **J. Rodriguez and J. Mantiplay** will share this role. They will pitch when the starter is pounded out and will finish the game. No innings limit. They will pitch extra innings until the issue is decided. The exception is, if the game becomes winnable, go to the best pitcher still available in the pen.

APR-AUG: **J. Rodriguez**
SEP-OCT: **Mantiplay**
NOV: **J. Rodriguez**
