3. Pinch Hitting - Bench is limited - rarely use Santander or Vogelbach (or Choi for Dalbec or visa versa) if game on line. Starting catcher stays in game unless injured - we just do not have extra games here.
4. Pinch Runner - No
5. Defensive Substitutes -initially, none.
6. Sacrifice; Any player not having a first column "1" on 66 - with bad shifts, will sac on no out, man on second or 1st and 2nd, pitcher "B" or better, score close, late. Ditto for man on first, steal not recommended (especially if adjusted pitching grade over 18). Squeeze bunt - ONLY with runners on 3rd, or 2nd and 3rd, 8th or later, score within 1, fast runner. Batter with less than 5-13's
7. Stealing 2nd: Pham, Wade, Canha, Adames and Fraley (when up) after 5th inning, score close. All could try to steal 3rd or home $9^{\text {th }}$ or later.
8. Hit and Run - runners listed for stealing can run in H\&R with man on first (any number of outs), or men on first and third with 0 or 2 outs if runner on first has adjusted SSN over 18. Batters eligible have less than double 1's, less then 4 walks.
9. Intentional Walk: If score not close late, big hitter can walk in front of whimp on 2 out, but don't put tying/winning run on base.
10. Pitch from Stretch: On 2 out, for adjusted SSN to steal home of 12 or more; on less than 2 out, with adjusted SSN of 15 or more (or 12 if pitcher grade 20 or more).
11. Hold runner: For 1B2 never! All others - always on none or 1 out; also on 2 out unless runner won't steal. 14. Infield deep before 6th, on 2 out, if score difference 3 or more, if man on 1st too. Otherwise play in.
12. Offensive runner advancement: By Adams tables. For computer game, when obvious (runner well around bag, or on single to right with runners on $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ and pitcher allows 8 's). Consider runner's speed.
13. Outfield throws: Never if runner has $33 / 36$ or better chance of safe advance (unless this scores winning run), cutoff automatic, trailing runners hold. Otherwise throw.
14. Injuries: Your judgment but see next page. Call: (978)-687-2124 for lineup if needed, just do your best. 18. Send runner on 3rd: On 2 out, your infield deep, or your defense below average (sum of $2 \mathrm{nd}+\mathrm{SS}+3 \mathrm{rd}$ basemen less than 19).
15. Defense against multiple steals: Pitch from stretch as appropriate. Hold ball and free steal of 2nd (no steal of home) for men on 1st and 3rd (unless \#12 applies); for runners on 1st and 2nd go for lowest SSN.

Set-up: $6^{\text {th }}$ through $8^{\text {th }}$ With GC lead or down by 1 , any grade 13-16. Losing -13 and down.
Middle: $6^{\text {th }}$ or $7^{\text {th }}$ grade 7 through 14 .
If grade 5 starters have lead, pull them before they lose it.
Lefty specialist: any LHP
Long: grade 6,7 better if GC lead or within 1
MOP - Lowest grade
STARTERS ARE NEVER EVER TO BE USED IN RELIEF (or more than 11.2 IP per start). Seven relievers are normally active, see active list and check email for limit on innings later in year. All starters leave when fatigued but protect leads after 5th. Starters grade 5 leave early IF GC can win, but will stay if losing bad immediately, or until pounded out. Better relievers (13* and up) for when we lead or down not more than 1. Grade 6, 7 or 10 when we are behind (lefties can pitch to big shift in their advantage). I would prefer to use a grade 13 or 14 when behind not too badly rather than use up my LHP. If behind by 3 or more starters may stay until pounded out but leave if GC makes comeback.
