PLAYER USAGE

In a close game, USE ANYONE ON THE BENCH EXCEPT Alvarez, Grossman, and O'Neill.

HIT AND RUN

Whenever legal (not with 2 out on the **Computer**) with:

- BATTERS: Hayes, Rosario, Smith, & Varsho
- RUNNERS: EVERYONE EXCEPT Alvarez, Jansen, Luplow, J.Rogers, Smith, and all pitchers

STEALING

- STEAL 2B when the H&R is not in order, the adjusted SSN is 27+, and there are 0-1 out in a close game with:
 - o Grossman, O'Neill and Rosario in the 3rd or later
 - Hayes, Lowe, Lux, Seager, Urias, and Varsho in the 7th or later
- STEAL 3B with NO OUT (or home with exactly 2 OUT) in the 7th or later when it's tied or we trail by a run with:
 - o Hayes, Lowe, Rosario, Urias, or Varsho

PINCH-HITTING

Anyone EXCEPT **Alvarez**, **Grossman**, and **O'Neill** can PH in a <u>close game</u> from the 6th on if we're behind or tied.

- Preferred vs. RHPs: Almonte, Frazier, Hayes, Lowe, Luplow (game-winning/tying only), or Seager
- Preferred vs. LHPs: Frazier, Hayes, Rosario, Seager, Senzel (game-winning/tying only), or Smith

PINCH-RUNNING

PR with Alcala, Almonte, Fried, Garza, Hayes, Rosario, or Ross for a SLOW runner if it's tied or we trail by a run, 7th or later. If you use a relief pitcher to PR, make sure we won't need him to pitch in the game.

SACRIFICE

RARE. No outs, runner on 2B who's NOT SLOW. Only with #7, 8 or 9 hitters, 7th or later, close game. Don't squeeze.

RUNNER ADVANCEMENT

- Board Game: Use Adams Tables.
- Computer Game: Play our team like you play yours.

DEFENSIVE STRATEGY >>>

- HOLD AT 1B: Always, except with PR batter or with a runner who is no threat to steal.
- INFIELD IN: Runner on 3B, score +/-1 run, 8th inning on, less than 2 out. Play deep if there's a chance for a DP.
- THROW: Runner with < 32 chances for an important run.

PITCHING STRATEGY >>>

MANAGING THE STARTERS

Five rules this year:

- 1. Never remove a starter throwing a shutout.
- 2. No starter pitches 12.0 innings in any game.
- 3. Grade 9+ starters pitch until fatigued unless it's a (+/-5) blowout. Then leave them in until it gets closer.
- 4. Grade 6 starters MUST pitch at least 5 full innings unless pounded out of the game.
- 5. The openers (**Bender**, **Castro**, **Graterol**, and **Howard**) pitch until fatigued AND they put a man in scoring position. **Sborz/Cotton** is usually the first reliever in.

USING THE BULLPEN

The bullpen has **587.3 innings** of relief for the year (~**3.7 innings per game**), with **516.0 innings** (**3.3 innings per game**) of Grade 9* or better. Move relievers in and out to make use of the +5 bonus in close games (+/-2 runs).

There will always be 7 active relievers, but usually only one active lefty. The mops aren't always active, so the early guys act as mops during those months.

I recognize that managing the visiting team's bullpen is a difficult task for the home manager. Do the best you can to win with what we have once you take the starter out.

Closer (C): New closer Romano has 63.0 innings to pitch when it's tied or we have a 1–3-run lead in the 8th inning or later. He can get 4 outs. LIMIT: 1.3 INNINGS PER GAME.

Setup (1): With **60.3 innings**, **Bender** pitches when it's tied or we lead by 3 runs or less in the 7th and 8th innings. **LIMIT**: **1.3 INNINGS PER GAME**.

Middle (2): With 142.0 innings, Castro & Santillan/Garza pitch in close games (+/-2 runs) from the 6th to the 8th. Castro has 68.3 innings, and Santillan/Garza have a combined 73.7 innings. Two of these pitchers are active every month. Santillan gets just 26.7 innings with the +5 bonus. LIMIT: 2.0 INNINGS PER GAME EACH.

Early (3): With 154.3 innings, Alcala, Diplan/Sborz & Ross pitch in the 5th on as a bridge or a mop. Alcala has 59.7 innings, and Sborz/Cotton have a combined 89.0 innings. Two of these pitchers are active every month. LIMIT: 2.0 INNINGS/GAME EACH.

Lefty: With **96.3 innings**, **Minter/Howard** face one or more batters anytime. Since only one is active, you get to decide the best time. **LIMIT: 1.7 INNINGS PER GAME**.

Mop (M): Graterol, when available, comes in whenever a game is out of hand. He gets one start in November, but he has 66.3 innocuous innings. NO LIMIT
