Starters are generally to pitch until fatigued or otherwise reduced in grade.

Bullpen

Chargois is the closer for all one inning save opportunities (i.e. Rye ahead by 1 to 3 runs), although Bickford or McFarland can be used in the last inning, particularly if a 5 point bump is good to get a critical or last out. We don't care who gets saves. Bickford is the setup man for one or two innings in close games. LHP McFarland is available for lefties and an inning or so in mid-game. Brogdon and Sawamura pitch 4th-7th in close games. Coulombe is a situational lefty. Coulombe and Pop are long relief/mops.

Generally, relievers are to pitch less than 2 2/3 innings per game.

Offense

Hit and Run – With a batter with 2 -31's at the plate and a guy on first with 0 or 1 out, consider the H&R with a net steal number of 24+ on first. We have twelve guys with a steal rating of 25 or higher, and who may have a net steal number of 24, so this is going to happen frequently. Look for it. Use it, please. If ahead or behind by 3 or more, don't use the H&R.

Stealing - Merrifield needs to run. D35 and 44 SBA's. He can regularly steal second. When behind by 1 or tied with 0 or 1 out, he can steal second and third to manufacture a run. Fletcher, Kemp and Realmuto can steal second in close games. Consider it.

Base Advances – Use the Adams Tables.

Bench –Use your judgment, but look at the bench late in games to create an edge. Consider pinch hitting or pinch running to create an edge. Don't use Realmuto, Meyers, DeJong or Jankowski when they don't start. Joe Musgrove (Sp 15) can pinch run when he doesn't start.

Defensive Replacements – Late in the game with a one or two run lead bring in Heredia to play right field. That's it.
