**2022 Outlook**: We are in the hunt for the playoffs and another title. The offense and defense are solid. As for pitching, we have 95 Gr 8-13 starts but the remaining starts are dubious. Therefore, we will be carrying at least 8 in the pen every month. Our relief corps has over 700 innings available. 192 inn. of Closers, 206 inn. of Gr 14/15, and 304 inn. of Gr 8-12. The Gr 8-12 sextet of relievers will be known as the <u>Caddy Crew@</u> and should be used freely and quickly in tandem with weak starters to try and keep us in games.

## <u>OFFENSIVE STRATEGY</u>

### STEAL: Strategy #1

**1)** Arozarena, Bichette, Frazier, Mondesi, & Newman can steal 2<sup>nd</sup> OR 3<sup>rd</sup> from the 3<sup>rd</sup> inning on when Adams Tables eligible and score is STM +2/-2. They steal home from 7th on when Adams Tables eligible if lead run & 2 outs.

### HIT & RUN: Strategy #2

- 1) Gurriel, Newman, & Plawecki H&R with a runner on 1st who has an adjusted SSN of 20 or more who is NOT slow
- 2) Do not H&R with runners on 1st & 3rd
- 3) *Computer players* if there are 2 outs, H&R only if Arozarena, Bichette, Frazier, Mondesi, or Newman are on 1st

### SACRIFICE: Strategy #3

1) Hedges, Newman, and Wynns will sacrifice runner(s) from 2<sup>nd</sup> OR 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 5<sup>th</sup> or later, 0 outs only

**<u>PINCH HITTING or RUNNING</u>**. See Strategy/Roles chart above. Make sure defensive coverage is available if PH in 9<sup>th</sup>.

### **RUNNER ADVANCEMENT:**

- **1)** Always go if chance is 24+ for home and 30+ for 3B. Otherwise, use Adams Tables.
- 2) *Computer game -* use the standards for advancement that you use for your team.



# <u>DEFENSIVE STRATEGY</u>

**DEFENSIVE REPLACEMENTS:** See Strategy/Roles chart above. For injuries, use your best judgment.

### HOLD / DON'T HOLD RUNNER: Always hold.

### **INFIELD IN:**

- 1) Runner on 3rd only: 0 or 1 out, 4th inning or later, STM +1 to -2,
- 2) Runners on 1st and 3rd: 6th inning or later, 0 out, STM +1 to -2,
- **3)** 2nd & 3rd OR Bases Full: only if winning run at 3rd, 9th inning or later, 0 or 1 out. **EXCEPTION** with 1 out, Bases Full, play deep if batter has 3 or more 24s.

### **OUTFIELD THROWS:**

- **1)** Throw for lead runner if < 33 chances otherwise hold trailing runners.
- 2) In 6th inning or later, hold trailing runner if they are tying run UNLESS lead runner has <16 chances.
- 3) *Computer game –* based on the game situation, use standards for throws that you use for your team.

**INTENTIONAL WALKS:** If lead run is in scoring position after 4th inning & 1B open, issue free pass with:

- 1) 1 out to set up the double play unless on-deck hitter is superior to player to be walked,
- 2) 2 out to get to a much more inferior hitter,
- **3)** NEVER walk the bases full.

**<u>PITCH FROM THE STRETCH</u>**: Runner on 3rd, 5th inning or later, 2 outs, STM +1 to -1, and adjusted SSN > 10.

### <u>MANAGING THE PITCHING STAFF</u>

#### <u>STARTERS:</u>

1. Bassitt and Wheeler – <u>the workhorses</u>

(A) do not leave before the 6<sup>th</sup> unless forced out by runs, (B) should be replaced after being fatigued from 6<sup>th</sup> on, (C) if not fatigued and no grade advancement possible, replace them to start the 7<sup>th</sup> if STM -1 to +4.

- 2. Houck and Pineda <u>the workponies with low fatigue</u>
   (A) do not leave before the 5<sup>th</sup> unless forced out by runs, (B) should be replaced after being fatigued from 5<sup>th</sup> on,
   (C) if not fatigued and no grade advancement possible, replace them to start the 6<sup>th</sup> if STM -1 to +4.
- *3.* Canning, Carrasco, and Fedde *the other arms who have the starts we need to be legal* 
  - (A) will be used "like" openers and in dire need of the <u>Caddy Crew@</u> to try and help them early,
  - (B) will pitch the first 2 innings OR relieve them immediately if they give up 3 runs before the 3rd inning,
  - (C) from the 3<sup>rd</sup> inning on and STM down by any number of runs to +4, relieve them the next instance they allow a run OR allow a runner in scoring position.

### <u>BULLPEN:</u>

- 1. **Lugo, Middleton, Ottavino, Patton, Romo, and Zimmer** (304.3 inn) make up the <u>*Caddy Crew©*</u>. Not all will be up every month. Try to save them as much as you can for Canning, Carrasco, and Fedde starts while balancing their workload in those games. Romo and Zimmer have 16+ innings each to use in the months they are up the rest have over 10 innings each, every month. They can pitch later in any game if score STM +6 or -5 or more.
- 2. Boxberger, Smith, and Trivino (206.3 inn) are the 5<sup>th</sup> 7<sup>th</sup> inning pitchers.
- 3. Antone & Pomeranz (59.3 inn) come in from 5<sup>th</sup> on to stop a rally if score is STM -3 to +3 for ONLY an out or two.
- 4. In a perfect world **Jackson** (63.7) sets-up and **Clase** (69.7) closes. Both can enter with a couple outs (Jackson in the 7<sup>th</sup> inning, Clase in the 8<sup>th</sup> inning) if STM ahead by < 4 and Antone or Pomeranz not available to get an out.
- 5. In a non-perfect world, all grade 18 and above relievers can be used to protect 1 to 3 run leads from the 8<sup>th</sup> on.
- 6. <u>*Reliever limits per game:*</u> In general, <u>*Caddy Crew©*</u> pitchers 2.7 (see blowouts re: Romo and Zimmer); Antone & Pomeranz 0.7; all others up to 1.7.
- <u>BLOWOUTS</u>: Use Romo and Zimmer heavily in the months they are up. If score is STM -5 or more they can go up to 4.7 innings no matter if fatigued or reduced, then use any remaining <u>Caddy Crew@</u> evenly. If more pitchers needed after that use the others (EXCEPT for Antone and Pomeranz) as needed.
