Offensive Strategies

Strategy 1: Hit and Run. Hit and Run with a runner on first when legal using the combinations below. With runners on first and third employ the hit and run with two outs only.

Hitters: **Andrus, Carlson, Fortes, Gimenez, Gurriel, Marte, H. Ramirez**

Runners: **Andrus, Gimenez, Kiermaier, Mateo, Hicks**

Do not hit and run if your pitcher has a W on the computer or a control rating of -24 or worse on the boards.

Strategy 2: Steal. If the hit and run is not in order, **Gimenez, Andrus, Kiermaier, Mateo, Hicks** can attempt to steal second base from the 4th inning on if their adjusted SSN is 27 or more, and the score is within 3 runs.

Strategy 3: Sacrifice with the 8th and 9th place hitters if the score is tied or we're behind by one run AND there's a runner on 2nd base with no out AND it's the 7th inning or later

Runner Advancement:

Board Game – use Adams Tables

Computer Game – Go if “well around”, otherwise I'll defer to your expertise.

Pinch Hitting/ Running: The bench will be fluid from month to month. Look to PR for our slow/average runners (probably with **Mateo**) if they represent the tying or go-ahead run in the 8th inning or later.

When considering pinch hitting, weigh your bullpen options in response and proceed accordingly. Get the best defense afterward.

Injuries: Use your best judgement.

Defensive Strategies

- Runners on 1st: Hold non-slow runners with a base SSN of 24+ or if a PL is at bat.
- Play Infield in – Runner on 3rd, 0 or 1 out, 7th or later, Jets +1 to -4
- Intentional Walk: If it makes sense
- Pitch from stretch: Always when runners are on base
- Defensive Replacements: If we lead after hitting in the 8th inning. look to improve our OF defense, insert **Barnhart** at catcher and **Mateo** at SS.

Outfield Throws:

Always throw for the go-ahead run, 8th or later. Otherwise-

- Board Game – throw for lead runner with less than 33/36 chances, otherwise cut the throw to hold trailing runners.
 - Computer Game- Always throw for slow lead runner, throw for other runners unless “well around” otherwise cut the throw to hold trailers.

Pitching Strategy These are **general guidelines**. Make whatever pitching decisions you deem appropriate within the flow of the game. Never remove a starter who hasn't allowed an earned run and never let a starter pitch more than 11.7 innings.

Starters:

Strider: Pitches until downgraded/fatigued, or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 7th inning or later, score +/- 3 runs.

Springs, Kelly, and Nola: Remove if downgraded/fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 6th inning or later, score +/- 3 runs

Everyone else: Remove if downgraded/fatigued or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 5th inning or later, score +/- 3 runs.

Bullpen: Including Manaea (who will spend the season in long relief), there are more than 600 relief innings, most of them grade 13 or better. Once the starter is out, be aggressive with the pen, taking advantage of the +5 upgrades. As usual, the grades define the roles.

The closer is **Jason Adam (RH 25*)** with **JP Feyereisen (RH 24*)** occasionally stepping in when active. They can come in in the 8th if needed.

Set up roles belong to **Feyereisen, Matt Wisler (RH 17*)**, **Daniel Hudson (RH 16*)** and **Penn Murfee (RH 15*)**. They generally pitch the 7th and 8th innings in games that we're leading or within two runs.

Matt Bush (RH 14*), **Corey Knebel (RH 14*)**, **Matt Boyd (LH 13*)** and **Michael Fulmer (RH 10*)**, will fill the middle relief role. They will generally pitch after the starter is removed and we're tied or behind.

Taylor Rogers (LH 7*) and **Sean Manaea (LH 6 - no +5)** will fill the long relief/ mop-up role. Use them if the starter takes a 5 point downgrade in the first four innings or if the game is a lost cause (down 6 runs or more after the 6th inning).
