## HIT AND RUN

Yes! When legal (less than 2 out on the Computer) with:

- bAtTERS: Duran, Hayes, Rosario, and Wynns.

Add Brantley vs. a pitcher with +26 control (or a Z).

- RUNNERS: EVERYONE EXCEPT Garlick, Higgins, Jansen, Lowe, Olson, Urias, Waters, and Wynns.


## STEALING

- STEAL 2B when the H\&R is not in order, the adjusted SSN is $27+$, and there are $0-1$ out with:

1. Hayes, O'Neill, Rosario, and Varsho in the 3rd on
2. Duran, Grossman, and Lux in the 7 th on

- STEAL 3B with NO OUT (or HOME with 2 OUT) in the 7th or later when it's tied or we trail by a run with Duran.
- LIMIT STEAL ATTEMPTS to 1, except for Group 1 above.


## PINCH-HITTING

PH with ANYONE BUT Alvarez, Brantley, or O'Neill from the 6th on in a close game. Preferred hitters include:

- vs. RHPs: Duran, Garlick, Hayes, Higgins, Lowe, Lux, Rosario, Urias, Varsho, or Waters
- vs. LHPs: Garlick, Grossman, Hayes, Lowe, Refsnyder, Rosario, Urias, or Waters


## PINCH-RUNNING

PR with Duran (16 speed), Grossman (10), Hayes (13), Lowe (15), Lux (17), Rosario (16), Stroman (15), Varsho (15), or Waters (16) for a SLOWER runner if it's tied or we trail by a run, 6th or later.

## SACRIFICE

RARE. No outs, runner on 2B with 10+ speed. Only with \#8 or \#9 hitters, 6th or later, close game. Don't squeeze.

## RUNNER ADVANCEMENT

- Board Game: Use the Adams Tables aggressively.
- Computer Game: Play our team like you play yours.


## DEFENSIVE STRATEGY >>>

- HOLD AT 1B: Always, except against a PR batter.
- INFIELD IN: Runner on 3B, score +/-1 run, 7th inning on, less than 2 out. Play deep with 1 out, a chance for a DP.
- THROW: Runner with < 33 chances for an important run.

## MANAGING THE STARTERS

## Four rules this year:

1. No starter pitches 12.0 innings in any game.
2. Grade $9+$ starters pitch until fatigued unless it's a blowout (+/-5 runs). Leave them in until it gets closer.
3. Lower grade starters pitch at least 4 full innings. Look to rescue them in the 5th on in a close game.
4. The openers (Brebbia and Graterol) pitch until fatigued. Then go to the next arm with a better grade.

## USING THE BULLPEN

The bullpen has 555.0 innings of relief for the year ( $\sim 3.3$ innings per game), and all of them are Grade $8^{*}$ or better. Move relievers in and out to make use of the +5 bonus in close games (+/-3 runs).
There will always be 7 active relievers, including two lefties. The early guys can act as mops or bridges. Mix and match to avoid overusing any one reliever. Some guys share innings, so don't pull a short-inning reliever if that's what we need; let him pitch.
I recognize that managing the visiting team's bullpen is a difficult task for the home manager. Do the best you can to help us win once you've taken the starter out.

Closer (C): New closers Kinley and Robertson have 87.7 innings to pitch when it's tied or we have a 1-3-run lead in the 8th inning or later. They can get 5 outs if needed.
LIMIT: 1.7 INNINGS PER GAME. Note that Minter and Romano can close if Robertson struggles with control. We don't care who gets saves, only that we get wins.
Setup (1): With 199.0 innings, Minter, Romano, and Munoz pitch to keep a game close or protect a lead in the 6th to 8th innings. All three of these relievers are active each month. LIMIT: 2.0 INNINGS PER GAME EACH.

Middle (2): With 148.0 innings, Peralta, Strzelecki, and Graterol (with Anderson in November) pitch when the game's still close (+/-3 runs) from the 5th to the 7th. Peralta is always up. LIMIT for PERALTA: 1.3 INNINGS PER GAME. The other two swap in and out. LIMIT for OTHERS: 2.0 INNINGS PER GAME.

Early (3): With 120.3 innings, Ginkel, Castro, Brebbia and Cueto (when not starting) pitch early if a starter is pounded out or injured. They can also pitch later, if a game gets out of hand. Only one of these pitchers is active every month. Dunning provides insurance if we need more mop innings in relief. LIMIT: 2.7 INNINGS/GAME (or more, really, if we use them to save the other arms).
