## Hit and Run

Preferred over straight steal. Anytime score permits, SSN is 27+ and baserunner has not used up allotted steal attempts.
Batters: Solano, Naylor, Estrada, Nido, Gonzalez, LGonzalez
Runners: Judge, Lindor, Estrada, LGonzalez

Stealing ( $2^{\text {nd }}$ base only)
Estrada, Judge, Lindor anytime, any \# outs, score +/- 1 run, SSN 27+, twice per series max.
Naylor, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later, score tied, SSN $28+$, once per series.

## Sacrifice

Estrada, L Gonzalez, Solano, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later, score tied, 0 outs, steal not available Squeeze is OK with same scenario same hitters.

## Pinch Hitting

Only if score is $+/-2$ runs, $7^{\text {th }}$ or later.

## Outfield Throws

Always throw for lead runner if chances are $<32$, trailing runner if chances are $<20$, unless lead runner is tie or go ahead, $7^{\text {th }}$ or later.

## Hold Runner on First

Hold all runners except when all 3 conditions are met:

1) LH batter
2) $6^{\text {th }}$ inning or later
3) Runner speed <13

Play Infield In
Deep at all times except:

- $3^{\text {rd }}$ or $2^{\text {nd }} \& 3^{\text {rd }},<2$ outs, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later, tie or winning run.
- Bases full, 0 outs, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later, tie or winning run


## Defensive Replacements

Overall team defense is competent at best, with the infield being the weak spot. With no help on the bench, unless Leury Garcia gets called up in a moment of weakness, there is only one move to make:

Nido for Contreras, $8^{\text {th }}$ or later, ahead by 4 or less

Note: All OF-2's are CF eligible except Naylor

## Managing the Starters

Similar to many teams in TBL, we present with a starting staff of mostly double digit grades. This is a very middle of the road starting staff with no dominant ace. The good part of this group is there are no problems with HR ratings and just 1 with control issues. There are no rules carved in stone how these starters should be used. Short fatigue ratings may require a starter to work through a grade reduction, depending on the game situation. I'll leave the decision when to pull a starter (and a reliever as well) in your capable hands.

## Using the Bullpen

With only 1 bridge reliever in Kyle Nelson and his 36 innings, protecting a lead in $6-8^{\text {th }}$ innings could be a problem. After Nelson, it's a choice between a wild 24 (Williams), a problematic 13 (Drew Smith) and a competent 12 (Pallante) Check individual series instructions for usage \& inning limit goals.

Phillips (A), RHP: 63 innings, and Williams (A), 61 innings comprise this year's closers, although Williams may need to serve as the $8^{\text {th }}$ inning bridge to Phillips. Both can pitch in tie games but only max of 2 innings each in extras.

Nelson (B) LHP 36 innings; Drew Smith (B), RHP: 46 innings; Pallante (B) RHP 54 innings. These are the $6^{\text {th }}$ through $8^{\text {th }}$ relievers who job is to keep the game within 2 or 3 runs. Stripling's 11 innings can be used here if not starting.
Lugo (C) RH 65 innings; Richards (C) RP 60 innings; Of this group, Lugo could be used in higher leverage situations in $6^{\text {th }}$ or $7^{\text {th }}$. Richards (when active) should be the first in if we fall behind early, anywhere from $2^{\text {nd }}$ to $5^{\text {th }}$.
Arano RH 71 innings, King LH 76 innings, Moreta RH 38 innings (D) Arano \& King are innocuous grade 4's, along with Moreta, as an 8, are there to spare needless use of better relievers.
