

Brodingnag 2024 Emergency Instructions

We're better than last year, but not yet good. The names are better than the stats for too many players. We think a realistic win total is about 75. The good parts are good, but there are too many poor parts. But 75 wins should keep us in the division fight, but likely in 2nd or 3rd. We will do what we can, but don't sweat it if there is a difficult choice to make—just do what seems best—I trust your judgement.

I am writing these while still on the road essentially since early March. Don't have the cards and will get home April 1st in time for significant oral surgery. I want to get these out as soon as they have the minimum stuff, so I don't hold up opening day. I will send out improved ones as soon as I can.

- We will play the boards as usual
- We intend to send out instructions each month
- If you play on the computer, we do not need the game scripts
- These instructions are guidelines—use your judgement to override them **EXCEPT**:
 - Toro's at PAs are precious, do not over use them
 - Don't do things that change the starting rotation
 - Don't use Woodruff for more than 1.3 IP per game, and only in save situations

Bench Use:

- Catchers are PA limited, so they can PH for each other
- Toro is our Manny Mota—game deciding Abs only, Never before the 7th, Never stays in after the inning ends
- Straw is the PR and defensive OF
- Walker, de la Cruz, do **NOT** come off the bench.
- Cabrera (1B, 3B, OF), Garcia (2B, SS, 3B), & Bart (C) usable as needed.

Offensive Priorities:

We have a good bit of speed and need to use it

1. **Steal** 7th inning+, tie/win run on 1st
Acuna, de la Cruz, Straw on 1st
Any number of outs
2. **H&R** 1st & 3rd only, any inning if score +3 to -2
Acuna, de la Cruz, Straw on 1st
Any eligible batter, any inning
3. **Sac** Tie/win run on base
Runners on 1st, 2nd, or 1st & 2nd
No outs
Not Soto, Acuna, Machado, Campusano
or Toro at bat

Other Stuff:

These are our tendencies. Override if you see fit to do so

- We generally hold all runners unless they are N-rated SSM
- We generally play for the DP unless it is very obvious not to
- With speedy runners, be aggressive with baserunners
- Pitch from the stretch if the runner on 3rd is tie/win run, 8th+ inning, and I have a GD 18+ pitcher to that hitter

Starters

- We will use Woodruff's innings as our closer, so we have 21 starts of Gd 13, 62 of 5 & 4, the rest 9-11.
- All starters go 4 innings unless the rules force them out. Innings 5 & 6 remove if the score is -4 to +4 and the starter is fatigued.
- From innings 7+, if the starter's grade is less than a Gd 15 **AND** the score is +4 to -3 **AND** a runner gets on base **OR** the tie/win run is at bat
- No starter goes long enough to affect their next start

Relievers

- We will have 6 relievers active each month
- Closer all season: **Woodruff**. Save situations only.
- Inn 7+ if game is +4 to -3: **Kimbrell, Duran, Harvey**
All are RH, mix & match the two who are up each month
Try to keep their usage close to equal.
- All other situations, all other relievers
There will be 2 or 3 of them active each month
All RH, again spread the usage roughly even.
- Junis is also the mop-up guy, and the occasional starter. He will start 3 games including the May DH. The months Junis is not up, Santos is the Mop.

- Narvaez & Soderstrom, Bubic, Green, Buehler are in the minors until November
- ARP: Miller, Woo, Lynch, Duran, Gallegos also in minors
- MAY: Glasnow, Lambert, Lynch, Duran, Stanek in minors
- JUN: Glasnow, Woo, Lambert, Kimbrel, Junis in minors
- JUL: Labmbert, Lynch, Kimbrel, Stanek, Santos in minors
- AUG: Woo, Lambert, Lynch, Harvey, Gallegos in minors
- SEP: Glasnow, Lambert, Suarez, Harvey, Stanek in minors
- OCT: Lambert, Lynch, Flaherty, Kimbrel, Junis in minors
