

These are generic batting orders, to be used in an emergency. The roster will change monthly. I will provide a current roster and batting orders for each month. Refer to these instructions for all strategic decisions and how to utilize the pitching staff.

OFFENSIVE STRATEGY

HIT AND RUN: Starting in the 4th inning, score IND -3 to +1, less than two outs, HIT AND RUN!! Runners on 1st or 1st and 3rd: Blanco, Bogaerts, Freeman, Friedl, Robert, & Semien. At Bat: Bogaerts, Freeman, Friedl, Grissom, & Semien

STEALING: Game situation and score are the same as with the hit and run. Same designated runners on first base and a non hit and run batter at the plate. Straight steal second. All designated runners are limited to TWO steal attempts per series. This includes attempted steals from Hit and Run.

PINCH HITTING:

Against a LHP: 8th inning or later, winning or tying run in scoring position, Maldonado for Barnes; LeMahieu

Against a RHP: Same game situation as with a lefty, Barnes for Maldonado.

PINCH RUNNING:

Blanco can come off the bench to pinch run for any base runner not rated "F". When that baserunner is in scoring position and represents the winning or tying run. 8th inning or later. If **Blanco** runs for **Burger**, bring **LeMahieu** in to play 3B.

SACRIFICE:

7th inning or later to get winning or tying run into scoring position. And the H & R or straight steal is not an option. Batters: Any catcher & Kiner-Falefa can attempt to sacrifice.

RUNNER ADVANCEMENT:

BOARD GAME: Adam's Table

RUNNER ADVANCEMENT:

COMPUTER GAME:

"Well around the bag" ---- send the runner home, and a runner to 3rd if hit is to CF or RF.

If the fielder plays a hit "on the long bounce", Send the runner only if he's fast. Don't send him to 3rd. On doubles to RF line, send the fast runner home but hold the slow runner. An average speed runner can score if the OF arm is <30.

On well-hit drives to right-center, when bases empty, where the runner "hits 2nd under a full head of steam" --- try for third if he hit any triples (in the real-life MLB season).

On singles to LF, an average or fast runner can score – but no one has a good shot at 3rd. On singles to CF and RF, fast runners have a good shot at 3rd, all runners should try to score.

When the fielder "retreats to get it", send the runner home.

DEFENSIVE STRATEGY

OUTFIELD THROWS:

Throw for the lead runner unless the chances are 34+. Always throw for the tying/go-ahead runner starting in the 6th inning.

COMPUTER GAME: Follow the same principles for throwing at your runners as outlined for my runners.

HOLD RUNNER ON FIRST:

When 1B(4or5) is playing, always hold. Otherwise:

- a) Hold all fast runners.
- b) Hold all average runners unless I have a lead of 2 or more and there is a PR hitter.
- c) Hold slow runners only with a RH hitter or less than 2 out unless I lead by 2 or more.
- d) Do not hold "N" runners

PLAYING INFIELD IN:

PLAY 'IN' starting in the 6th inning, 0 or 1 out, tying or go-ahead run on 3rd.

INTENTIONAL WALK:

I only use this on those occasions when a monster hitter comes up with the game on the line. Your call.

PITCH FROM THE STRETCH:

Don't. We will take our chances throwing the runner out on any attempted steal of HOME.

COMPUTER NOTES:

- 1. Not necessary to send the game sheets/scripts for road computer games.
- 2. Do not use the computer manager function, prefer manual managing for the Indian road computer games.



DITCHING STRATEGY

The Indians pitching rotation for 2024 is a mish mash of low grade starters and Openers. Caddies and the bull pen will play a key role in maximizing the Indians' chances to eke out a win. The instructions below attempt to clarify the chaotic IND pitching situation.

MANAGING THE STARTERS (Excluding Quandrill, Bido, & Openers)

Unless pounded out, starters will pitch a minimum of <u>four innings</u>. If not fatigued, starters will pitch until fatigued. Then go to the pen. Use the middle relievers. Only use the set-up men and Closers if Calusa is winning, the game is tied, or Calusa is -2. If a Starter fails to complete the four innings, use the Long Reliever for up to 2.7 innings. Depending on the score, use the pen to finish the game.

QUANTRALL & Bido. Will pitch a minimum of three innings. They will continue to pich if IND is winning. If the game is tied or IND is losing use the Caddy assigned to them on the Rotation page for a maximum of 2.7 innings. Depending on the score, use the pen to complete the game.

OPENERS. (Yes they are still a thing) **Alexander, McHugh, & Mantiply** will all start games. They will pitch **three innings** or until they become fatigued. Whichever comes first. Each has been assigned a **CADDY** on the rotation page. The Caddy will pich upto **2.7 innings,** if necessary, to get to the **5th inning.** Then go to the pen to finish the game.

CADDIES. Are listed on the Rotation page for **Quantrill, Bido,** and **the Openers.** All Caddies are limited to **2.7 innings** per outing. The intent is to get to the **5th inning.** After the Caddy, go to the pen to finish the game depending on the score. As the season progresses and relief innings accumulate, Caddies may have to change. I will cover any necessary changes in my monthly instructions.

USING THE BULL PEN

CLOSER: Fairbanks, and Leclerc will serve as the CLOSER during the months listed below.

If needed they can pitch two innings in a save situation.

APR Fairbanks JUL Leclerc **OCT Fairbanks** MAY Leclerc **NOV Fairbanks AUG Fairbanks**

JUN Fairbanks SEP Leclerc

SETUP GUYS: Doval & Leclerc (When not a closer). They can pitch the 7th and 8th innings to get to a save situatuon.

All setup pitchers are limited to 3 innings per series.

MIDDLEMEN: Finnegan, Foley, & Erceg. Available to pitch the 5th and 6th innings when the starter is fatigued early. Two will be active each month. All three have Caddy dutues so watch for those games

All middle relievers are limited to 4 innings per series.

THE LEFTIES. S. Alexander, V. Gonzalez, J. Mantiply, B. Suter. First of all, check for their Caddy assignments. When active, they can pitch any time starting in the 5th inning, in a close game, and a tough hitter up with a negative split versus LHP and runners on base.. If you can counter punch with a plus pinch hitter, don't waste them.

LONG RELIEVER/EXTRA INNINGS: **C. McHugh** and **S. Alexander** will share this role. Both are innocuous and one will be active each month. When not a Caddy, they will pitch when the starter is pounded out before the 5th inning or when a game becomes non-winnable. Non-winnable is defined as Calusa is -6. In non-extra inning games, they are limited to 2.7 innings per game. If not completed, use lowest grade reliever still available to finish game. If not used, they will pitch extra inning games starting with the 13th inning until completion. This is an exception to the 2.7 inning limit.
