Offensive Strategies

Strategy 1: Hit and Run. Hit and Run with a runner on first when legal using the designations in the lineups above. With runners on first and third employ the hit and run with two outs only.

However, do not hit and run if your pitcher has a W on the computer or a control rating of -24 or worse on the boards.

Strategy 2: Steal. If the hit and run is not in order, **K. Marte, Raley, Kiermaier, Gimenez, Volpe, McKinstry, and Mateo** can attempt to steal second base from the 4th inning on if their adjusted SSN is 27 or more, and the score is within 3 runs.

Strategy 3: Sacrifice with the 8th and 9th place hitters if the score is tied or we're behind by one run AND there's a runner on 2nd base with no out AND it's the 7th inning or later

Runner Advancement:

Board Game – use Adams Tables

Computer Game – Go if “well around”, otherwise I'll defer to your expertise.

Pinch Hitting/ Running: The bench will be fluid from month to month. Look to PR for our slow/average runners if they represent the tying or go-ahead run in the 8th inning or later.

When considering pinch hitting, weigh your bullpen options in response and proceed accordingly. With that said, **Stewart** and **Sanchez** shouldn't be facing a LHRP in a +/-3 run game, 7th inning on. Get the best defense afterward.

Injuries: Use your best judgement.

Defensive Strategies

- Runners on 1st: Hold non-slow runners with a base SSN of 24+ or if a PL is at bat.
- Play Infield in – Runner on 3rd, 0 or 1 out, 7th or later, Jets +1 to -4
- Intentional Walk: If it makes sense
- Pitch from stretch: Always when runners are on base
- Defensive Replacements: If we lead after hitting in the 8th inning. look to improve our defense. Insert **Gimenez** at second and any OF3 for OF2.

Outfield Throws:

Always throw for the go-ahead run, 8th or later. Otherwise-

- Board Game – throw for lead runner with less than 33/36 chances, otherwise cut the throw to hold trailing runners.
- Computer Game- Always throw for slow lead runner, throw for other runners unless “well around” otherwise cut the throw to hold trailer

Starters: These are **general guidelines**. Make whatever pitching decisions you deem appropriate within the flow of the game. The only rules to follow are - never remove a starter who hasn't allowed an earned run and never let a starter pitch more than 11.7 innings.

- **Springs, Kelly, Strider and Faedo** pitch until fatigued/downgraded or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 6th inning or later, score within 3 runs either way.
- **Keller, France and Nola** pitch until fatigued/downgraded or if a base runner gets in scoring position, 5th inning or later, score within 3 runs either way.

Bullpen: Including Sears and Boyd (starters who will spend the season in the bullpen without benefit of the +5) we have over 550 innings of relief. Many of the middle relievers are short on innings so their usage will need to be monitored throughout the season. As usual, the grades define the roles.

- The closer role belongs to **Felix Bautista (RH28*)** with **Jay Jackson (RH20*)** filling in as needed. It's OK to use them earlier in any high leverage situation, whenever it occurs, as you see fit.
- Set up roles belong to **Jay Jackson, Jason Adam (RH17*)**, and **Luke Jackson (RH15*)**. They generally pitch the 7th and 8th innings in games that we're leading or within two runs.
- **Rogers (LH 14*)**, **Perdomo (LH 13*)**, and **Law (RH12*)** are middle relievers who come in after the starter is removed and the game is within three runs. Rogers and Perdomo are the better lefties in the pen. Use them in when the shifts are favorable and you're unlikely to bring in a pinch-hitter.
- **Penn Murfee**. A wild RH 14* with only 14 innings, he's likely to be waiver fodder. Get what you can out of him in April.
- **Sears and Boyd**. Left-handed starters who will pitch in relief. They have a lot of innings so use them when the starter is removed early, the game is out of hand late, or as a LOOGY when the situation presents itself and Rogers or Perdomo are unavailable.
