PLAYER USAGE

See <u>Playing the Havens by Position</u>. Everyone's available off the bench, some more often than others.

HIT AND RUN

Whenever legal (less than 2 out on the Computer) with:

- BATTERS: Duran, Hayes, Reyes, and Rosario. Add Refsnyder vs. a pitcher with +31 or better control.
- RUNNERS: ANYONE EXCEPT Alvarez, Grossman, Jansen, Olson, Rogers, Urias, and Velazquez

STEALING

- STEAL 2B when we can't H&R in a <u>close game</u>, with an adjusted SSN of 27+ and less than 2 out with:
 - 1. Duran, Hayes, Refsnyder, Reyes, Rosario, Varsho, Walls, and Waters in the 2nd on
 - 2. Add Lowe and O'Neill in the 7th on
- STEAL 3B with NO OUT (or HOME with 2 OUT) in the 7th or later, down 1 or tied, with Duran, Lowe, O'Neill, Rosario, or Walls.
- LIMIT ATTEMPTS to 1 each per series; except Group 1.

PINCH-HITTING

PH from the 6th on in a close game with:

- vs. RHPs: Alvarez (game-winning only), Duran, Lowe, Reyes, Urias, Velazquez, or Waters
- vs. LHPs: Alvarez (game-winning only), Grossman, O'Neill, Refsnyder, Reyes, Rogers, Urias, or Walls

PITCHING STRATEGY >>>

MANAGING THE STARTERS

Five rules this year:

- 1. No starter pitches 12.0 innings.
- 2. Dunning, Fried, and Stroman pitch to fatigue.
- 3. For **Irvin** and **Toussaint**, go to the bullpen as early as the 5th at 1st baserunner in a <u>close game</u> (+/-3 runs).
- 4. Anderson & Thompson need to pitch only 3 full innings. Rescue them if they give up a baserunner in the 4th or later in a <u>close game</u> (+/-3 runs), unless they haven't given up a run yet. Bring in the caddy first.
- The openers (Brebbia, Graterol, & Walker) pitch until fatigued (Graterol, two fatigues). Then go to the caddy (Robertson or Romano), except in blowouts.

USING THE BULLPEN

The bullpen has **588.0 innings** of good relief for the year (**~3.6 innings per game**). Use relievers in waves to stop a rally in <u>close games</u> (+/-3 runs). The caddy goes as long as effective, up to 2.7 innings.

We always have at least 7 active relievers. Don't overuse any of them. Some share innings (see details at right), so don't pull a short-inning reliever if he's what we need. The caddy should be the first reliever in a <u>close game</u>.

PINCH-RUNNING

PR for SLOWER runner, down 1 or tied, 6th on, with:

- Walls (16 speed), Waters (16), Stroman (15), Reyes (13), or Refsnyder (11) if available. Otherwise use:
- O'Neill (17), Duran (16), or Lowe (15)

SACRIFICE

RARE. No outs, runner on 2B isn't SLOW. Only with #8 or #9 hitters, 6th or later, <u>close game</u>. Squeeze with **Reyes**.

RUNNER ADVANCEMENT

- Board Game: Use the Adams Tables.
- Computer Game: Play our team like you play yours.

DEFENSIVE STRATEGY >>>

- HOLD AT 1B: Always.
- INFIELD IN: Runner on 3B, ahead by 1 run, 7th inning on, less than 2 out. Play deep with 1 out, chance for a DP.
- THROW: Always when runner is tying/winning run; otherwise, throw for runner with 33 chances or less.

Managing the visiting team's bullpen is a difficult task. Do the best you can to help us win once the starter's out.

Closer (C): New closer **Graterol** has **65.3 innings** to pitch when it's tied or we have a 1–3-run lead in the 8th inning or later. He can get up to 5 outs, but pull him immediately if you tie the game. <u>LIMIT: 1.7 INNINGS PER GAME</u>.

Setup (1): With 119.3 innings, Ginkel and Peralta are available to keep a game close or protect a lead in the 7th and 8th innings. Peralta can act as a LOOGY or go longer. LIMIT: 1.7 INNINGS PER GAME EACH.

Middle (2): With **149.0 innings, Muñoz/N.Anderson** (**84.3 innings**) and **Minter** do the bulk of the work when we lead from the 5th to the 7th. **Minter** can pitch earlier if needed. <u>LIMIT: 1.7 INNINGS PER GAME EACH</u>.

Caddy (3): With 124.3 innings, Romano/Robertson pitch in a <u>close game</u> (+/-3 runs), often as the first reliever in the game. They caddy for **Anderson**, **Thompson**, and the openers, so they need to be available for those games. Otherwise, they're flexible. <u>LIMIT: 2.7 INNINGS PER GAME</u>.

Early (4): With **226.3 innings**, the other relievers (and **Manoah**, who gets no +5 bonus) pitch early if a starter is pounded out or later if a game gets out of hand. Usually, only one is active each month. <u>LIMIT: NO LIMITS</u>.
