## **NOTES:**

**PINCH-HITTING:** The best 9 are on the field, so the platoon positions are the only one that it may be needed for late in the game.

**PINCH-RUNNING:** Allen in 8<sup>th</sup> or later, tying/lead run on 2<sup>nd</sup> for any S runner

**HIT & RUN:** This is PRIORITY #1 for the season. 5th inning on, **score +/-1**, runner adjusted 27+ SSN

**STEALS:** Only straight steal in the 7th or later with the tying/lead run, SSN 26+.

**SACRIFICE:** None

**BASERUNNING:** Master Game: Use Adams Table. Computer game: Use your own judgment.

**DEFENSIVE REPLACEMENTS:** Moreno for Jeffers, 8<sup>th</sup> inning on, 1-3 run lead

**OUTFIELD THROWS:** I will trust your judgment here.

**INFIELD:** The infield will be back unless it is the 8th or later, there are less than 2 outs, and the tying/lead run is on 3rd base and there is no DP possibility.

**HOLD:** Master Game: Hold if runner has a 26+ chance. Computer Game: Always

**STRETCH:** Always

**INTENTIONAL WALK:** Only to set up a DP in the 9th or later with a weaker hitter on deck and the game score +/- 1.

**STARTING PITCHING:** We **STILL** believe that the starters will pitch to their fatigue rating. Do not remove during a shutout; no starter goes more than 10.2 IP.

## **RELIEF PITCHING:**

**Closer (9th inning on):** Miller is the closer. Use only in tie/save situations. 9<sup>th</sup> inning only!

**Set-up (7<sup>th</sup> inning on):** Pivetta(when not starting),Topa and Coulombe are the setup men.

**Middle Relief (5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> inning):** Merryweather/Peguero/Chafin will fill this role

**Mop-up/Caddie Crew:** Holderman/Shaw/Moran/Beck will take care of this role. They will be the caddies for Corbin as needed. They can pitch 2.2 IP every outing.
